- -My role first and foremost is to represent to the best of my ability the people who elected me, the residents of Tonteg.
- -I attend meetings of the Full Council and the Pensions Committee of which I am a member.
- -To raise with the relevant council department issues and/or concerns that are raised with me.
- -To keep those who I represent informed of decisions taken by the council which affect them.
- -To scrutinise the decision making of the cabinet and the executive.
- -To hold myself to the highest possible standards at all times.

Section 2: Constituency Activity

- -I frequently deliver, to every household in Tonteg, an inTouch newsletter, informing residents of local news and the work that I am carrying out on their behalf.
- -I hold quarterly advice surgeries in the cabin behind Tonteg Community Centre, where residents can discuss any issues they wish with me.
- -I attend home visits to residents in the Tonteg ward if they so wish.
- -I attend as many community events in and around Tonteg as I can, such as the Ysgol Ty Coch Christmas Fair and the Llantwit Fardre Community Council Christmas Fete.
- -I attend and volunteer at the monthly Farmers Market which is held at the Tonteg Community Centre.
- -I volunteer at the Care for the Elderly `Afternoon Tea` which is held at various locations in the Llantwit Fardre Community Council area.
- -I regularly report potholes, broken pavements and broken streetlights on behalf of residents.
- -I am a committee member and volunteer at the Tonteg Community Centre.
- -I frequently attend the local PACT meeting with the local PCSO and liaise with the police regarding crime and antisocial behaviour in Tonteg.
- -I regularly attend Llantwit Fardre Community Council meetings to be kept informed of decisions affecting Tonteg and its residents.
- -I have a Facebook Page `Cllr Lewis Hooper` which I regularly use to update residents of upcoming events, recently made decisions and how I can be contacted.

Section 3: Initiatives and Special Activities

Over the last twelve months I have worked on several initiatives for the ward of Tonteg.

-Organised a petition on behalf of residents of Church Road and the surrounding streets calling for

traffic calming measures along Church Road, which I submitted at a Full Council meeting.

- -Met with road safety officers to call for traffic calming measures and/or a crossing outside Gwauncelyn Primary School.
- -Met with planning officers and local residents regarding a planning application affecting Tonteg and subsequently raised these concerns at a meeting of the Planning and Development Committee.
- -Met with highways department officers and wrote to the Cabinet Member responsible for Highways regarding the heavy congestion on Power Station Hill.
- -Contacted the relevant bodies to seek a solution to the excessive parking around both Gwauncelyn Primary School and Ysgol Ty Coch.
- -Campaigned for better play facilities at the play park in the Dell, including a resurfacing of the play park surface.
