Housing (Wales) Act 2014

1. PURPOSE OF THE REPORT

To seek approval that Rhondda Cynon Taf Council continues to apply the 'intentionality test' and publishes its intent to do so in accordance with Welsh Government direction.

In accordance with the council's Scheme of Delegation, this report has been prepared to accompany the intended Officer decision of the Group Director, Community & Children's Services as described below.

2. **RECOMMENDATIONS**

It is recommended that:

Rhondda Cynon Taf does not exclude any of the groups named in section 4.3.5 of the Cabinet report of the 19th March (<u>Cabinet 19-Mar-2015</u>), but rather continues to apply the 'intentionality test' to all of them and publishes its intent to do so in accordance with the Welsh Government guidance.

3. BACKGROUND

Cabinet received a report on the 19th March, 2015 on the implications for the Council of the Housing (Wales) Act 2015 and approved the recommendations contained therein (<u>Cabinet 19-Mar-2015</u>), in particular the 2nd recommendation that referred to section 78 of the Act regarding intentionally homeless'.

The Council, along with all other Councils in Wales, received a subsequent communication from the Welsh Government informing us that, at the point in time the Cabinet approved the recommendations in the report, it did not have the legal authority to actually make the decision on 'intentionally homeless' and would only have that power after the regulations came into force on 27th April, 2015.

4 CONCLUSION

By not removing the intentionality test at this point in time we are advocating an interim position between now and the future removal of the 'intentionality test' by Welsh Government, whereby the intentionality test is used in a positive way to lever, where appropriate the co-operation from 'intentionally homeless' households to work in collaboration with the Council to recognise and address underpinning issues for their homelessness or threatened with homelessness state.
