Note: With the permission of the Chairman, County Borough Councillor P.Jarman spoke on this item and expressed concern that whilst a response was made by the WLGA on behalf of local authorities in Wales to the Devolution, Democracy and Delivery White Paper, she felt that this was a matter for consideration by the Council as a whole and therefore a response also by this Council.

 The need to provide Cabinet with details of the content of the Devolution, Democracy and Delivery White Paper – Reforming Local Government and the Voluntary Merger Prospectus recently published by the Minister and further information to allow Cabinet to consider the merits of investigating a merger with a neighbouring authority and to make recommendations to Council accordingly.
