#### 1. DECISION MADE:

### Agreed -

- That in Pontypridd and Aberdare, the Council's car parking charges, including season ticket charges, be revised as per the proposed new tariffs consulted upon
- 2. That a flat rate of £1 for all day parking is introduced across long-stay car parks for Saturdays in Pontypridd and Aberdare.
- 3. That the Council retain the existing period of a month of free parking, after 10am, across car parks in Pontypridd and Aberdare town centres during the month of December.
- 4. That a feasibility study be undertaken with regard to the possible future introduction of card payment facilities and mobile technology
- 5. To introduce free parking in Pontyclun, Tonypandy, Porth and Mountain Ash town centres and to authorise the responsible Directors to take forward discussions with Pontyclun Community Council in respect of the Lease Tenure arrangement for Pontyclun car park.
- 6. To introduce a maximum-stay parking restriction of 4-hours across Council short-stay pay and display car parks and at those short-stay car parks where charging has been abolished.
- 7. To reaffirm the Council's commitment to continue providing free car parking for disabled badge holders in disabled parking bays in all Council car parks
- 8. That these changes be implemented on 1<sup>st</sup> April, 2017.

## 2. REASON FOR THE DECISION BEING MADE:

 The need to provide detailed feedback from the 6-week public consultation period during November – December 2016 with respect to proposed changes to the Council's existing car park charging regime and to help inform a cabinet decision on the way forward.

CONSULTATION UNDERTAKEN PRIOR TO DECISION BEING MADE:  From November – December 2016, a 6-week public consultation was undertaken to seek views on proposed new car parking charges in Rhondda Cynon Taf. The consultation took the forms of an online questionnaire, to which over 500 responses were received, and direct engagement via town centre public consultation events in Pontypridd, Aberdare, Mountain Ash, Tonypandy and Porth.
