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FINANCING OF HAWTHORN POOL REPAIRS USING PRUDENTIAL BORROWING

1. <u>PURPOSE OF THE REPORT</u>

1.1 The purpose of this report is to seek Council's approval for the repairs to Hawthorn Pool to be part funded through borrowing, using powers available under the Prudential Code.

2. <u>RECOMMENDATION</u>

It is recommended that (subject to Cabinet approval on the 22nd October 2015) Members:

2.1 Agree that costs of £0.520M are funded through borrowing, using the Council's powers under the Prudential Code, with the annual revenue cost of £0.040M being met from savings from the transfer of the operational management of the facility to the Governing Body of Hawthorn High School.

3. BACKGROUND

- 3.1 On the 22nd October 2015 Cabinet will consider a report which recommends the transfer of operational responsibility of Hawthorn Swimming Pool and associated facilities to the Governing body of Hawthorn High School.
- 3.2 It further recommends that repairs are undertaken to the pool hall roof, the remainder of the pool building and the school external changing rooms and that these works be funded from a combination of existing resources and Prudential Borrowing.

4. **FINANCIAL DETAILS**

4.1 In order to invest £0.770M on repairs to Hawthorn Pool it is proposed to use £0.250M of the existing Education Capital Programme and £0.520M of Prudential Borrowing secured from revenue savings (£0.040M, over 20 years) from the transfer of the operational management of the facility to the Governing Body of Hawthorn High School.

5. <u>CONCLUSION</u>

5.1 This report sets out the prudential code borrowing requirements as part of the financing arrangements for the repair works to Hawthorn Pool.
