"This Council recognises the serious dangers posed by Sepsis, which claims the lives of 44,000 people in the UK every year.

Known as the `silent killer`, it is the leading cause of avoidable death in the UK and occurs when the body violently responds to an infection by attacking its own organs.

The Council recognises the steps taken by the Welsh Government in becoming the first country in the World to introduce a system of early escalation of deteriorating patients, and the work done through the 1,000 Lives Programme which raises awareness of Sepsis within the NHS.

Also acknowledges the need to increase awareness amongst the public, particularly in light of the often seemingly flu-like symptoms.

This Council therefore RESOLVES to:
Support the call for the Welsh Government to undertake a Sepsis Public Awareness Campaign to improve outcomes for survivors and those affected.

Take steps to promote education and awareness of the symptoms of Sepsis across the County Borough including the Council's staff network".
