APPOINTMENT OF THE VICE-CHAIR OF AUDIT COMMITTEE FOR MUNICIPAL YEAR 2018 - 2019

REPORT OF THE DIRECTOR OF COMMUNICATIONS AND INTERIM HEAD OF DEMOCRATIC SERVICES

1. PURPOSE OF THE REPORT

To consider the decision of the Audit Committee to defer the appointment of the Vice-Chair of that Committee, for the 2018-2019 Municipal Year, to full Council.

2. RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that:

2.1 Members consider the resolution by the Audit Committee to defer the appointment of the Vice-Chair of the Audit Committee for the 2018-2019 Municipal Year to full Council.

3. REASON FOR RECOMMENDATION

3.1 The need to appoint a Vice-Chair of the Audit Committee for the 2018–2019 Municipal Year.

4. BACKGROUND

- 4.1 Under the provisions of the Local Government (Wales) Measure 2011 (the 'Measure') it is the responsibility of the Audit Committee to appoint the person who is to Chair that Committee.
- 4.2 The terms of reference of the Audit Committee, as contained in Part 3 (Responsibility For Functions) of the Council's Constitution, stipulate that "at the first meeting of the Audit Committee following the Council's Annual General Meeting the Audit Committee shall appoint the Chair of the Audit Committee (who cannot be a member who belongs to a group with Members in the Executive but can be a lay member) and appoint the Vice-Chair of the Audit Committee."

- 4.3 At the first meeting of the Audit Committee following the Annual General Meeting, held on 12th July 2018, the Committee failed to elect a Vice-Chair for the Committee for the 2018–2019 Municipal Year.
- 4.4 At the Audit Committee meeting held on 17th September 2018, following consideration of the minutes of its July meeting, the Committee resolved that the decision as to the appointment of the Vice-Chair for the 2018–2019 Municipal Year be deferred to full Council.
- 4.5 Members are now asked to consider the deferral of the appointment of the Vice-Chair of the Audit Committee for the 2018-2019 Municipal Year to full Council.
