HYSBYSIAD (MESURAU ARAFU TRAFFIG) 2022

DATGANIAD O'R RHESYMAU

Yn dilyn cymeradwyo cynlluniau ar gyfer adeiladu Depo Metro newydd yn Ffynnon Taf, mae angen darparu llwybr teithio llesol **dros dro** ar hyd Heol y Fynwent er mwyn dargyfeirio llywbr Taith Taf yn ystod y gwaith adeiladu.

Mae'r cynigion wedi bod yn destun dyluniad, archwiliadau diogelwch ffyrdd ac adolygiad manwl gan yr Adran Rheoli Datblygu Priffyrd, Trafnidiaeth Cymru (Swyddog Teithio Llesol) a chynrychiolwyr Sustrans. Ystyri'r cynigion yn angenrheidiol ar gyfer dargyfeirio llwybr Taith Taf am gyfnod dros dro tra bod y gwaith adeiladu ar hyd Ffordd Bleddyd.

Fodd bynnag, byddai'r lôn feicio a'r mesurau arafu traffig ar Ffordd y Fynwent yn darparu buddion diogelwch ffyrdd a theithio llesol hirdymor i drigolion Tŷ Rhiw ar ôl cwblhau gwaith Depo'r Metro ac felly byddai modd eu cadw'n barhaol pe bai cefnogaeth gyhoeddus i wneud hynny.

Bydd y mesurau yn gwella diogelwch priffyrd a cherddwyr trwy ddarparu amgylchedd cyflymder isel ar hyd Ffordd y Fynwent, Ffynnon Taf.

Mae'r mesurau arafu traffig arfaethedig yn hyrwyddo amcanion llesiant y Cyngor sydd yn eu tro yn cefnogi saith nod llesiant Deddf Llesiant Cenedlaethau'r Dyfodol (Cymru) 2015.

(TRAFFIC CALMING MEASURES) NOTICE 2022

STATEMENT OF REASONS

Following successful planning approval for the construction of a new Metro Depot in Taffs Well, there is a requirement to provide a **temporary** active travel route along Cemetery Road to accommodate the diversion of the Taff Trail for the duration of the construction works.

The proposals have been subject to detailed design, road safety audits and review by Highway Development Control, Transport for Wales (Active Travel Officer) and representatives of Sustrans and are considered necessary to accommodate the temporary diversion of the Taff Trail whilst construction works along Ffordd Bleddyd are ongoing.

However, the cycle lane and traffic calming features on Cemetery Road would provide long-term road safety and active travel benefits for the residents of Ty Rhiw following the completion of the Metro Depot works and therefore could be retained permanently should there be public support to do so.

The measures will improve highway and pedestrian safety by providing a low speed environment along Cemetery Road, Taffs Well.

The proposed traffic calming measures promotes the Council's well-being objectives which in turn supports the seven well-being goals of the Well-being of Future Generations (Wales) Act 2015
