Cwm Clydach, Strydoedd Amrywiol – Newidiadau i Linellau Dwbl Melyn a Marciau Safle Bws newydd yn Stryd Howard.

Efallai'ch bod chi'n gwybod yn barod, mae'r Cyngor wedi ymgynghori ar gynigion i wneud newidiadau i gyfyngiadau parcio yng Nghwm Clydach. Mae'r Cyngor wedi adolygu'r ymatebion ac wedi gwneud ychydig o newidiadau yn seiliedig ar adborth. Er budd diogelwch y ffordd, y bwriad yw ailosod darnau byr o linellau dwbl melyn ar Stryd Marian mewn sawl lleoliad cyffordd (cafwyd gwared ar y rhan fwyaf o gyfyngiadau ar Stryd Marian yn ystod gwaith ail-wynebu'r ffordd yn y gorffennol).

Clydach Vale, Various Streets – Alterations to Double Yellow Lines and New Bus Stop Markings at Howard Street.

As you may be aware, the council has consulted on proposals to make changes to parking restrictions in Clydach Vale. The Council has reviewed the responses and made some minor changes, based on feedback. In the interests of road safety, it is proposed to re-instate short sections of double yellow lines on Marian Street at several junction locations (most restrictions on Marian Street were removed previously during re-surfacing works).

Also proposed is the removal of double yellow lines on parts of Wern Street, to provide extra on-street parking space. Proposals to change the extents of double yellow lines at the top end of Howard Street and introduce a new bus stop marking are also shown. New double yellow lines to both Morton Terrace junction and High Street junction with Wern Street are shown also.

Details of the proposals are shown on the attached drawings TM23/034/PN and TM23/035/PN, which may also be viewed at www.rctcbc.gov.uk/traffic.

The next stage in the process will be to give a period of Public Notice of the proposals, where details of the scheme are advertised to provide opportunity for members of the public to formally raise any comments they may have. If you wish to comment on the proposals, you should do so in writing by **17 March 2023**, to the Traffic Services Manager, Traffic Management, Sardis House, Sardis Road, Pontypridd, CF37 1DU or alternatively by email at trafficservices@rctcbc.gov.uk
