Venue: The Clubhouse, Pontypridd Rugby Club, Sardis Rd, Pontypridd, CF37 1HA.

By road:

From the M4:

Take Junction 32 onto the A470 following the signs for Merthyr Tydfil. Take the exit signposted Pontypridd and Ynysybwl and follow the road around to the left past the *Unity* sculpture. At the traffic lights, head right towards the Rhondda Valleys. After passing Pontypridd Train Station on your left, the road veers around to the left under a bridge, take the first left at the traffic lights and Pontypridd Rugby Football Club is on your right.

From North Wales:

Follow the A470 south, and take the exit signposted Pontypridd and Ynysybwl. At the roundabout take the third exit heading back towards the A470, at the next roundabout, take the second exit for Pontypridd and the Rhondda Valleys heading past the *Unity* sculpture. At the traffic lights, head right towards the Rhondda Valleys. After passing Pontypridd Train Station on your left, the road veers around to the left under a bridge, take the first left at the traffic lights and Pontypridd Rugby Football Club is on your right.

• On Site Parking: Overflow (Sardis Road Car Park opposite)

By rail:

• From Aberdare, Merthyr Tydfil or Treherbert:

Trains southward will take you directly to Pontypridd.

• From all other locations:

Change at Cardiff Central or Cardiff Queen Street for trains to Pontypridd.

• At Pontypridd Train Station:

Leave via the main station exit and head left past Capel Sardis (Sardis Chapel). The road veers around to the left under a railway bridge, take the first left at the traffic lights and Pontypridd Rugby Football Club is on your right.
