SUBJECT: Re-tender of a Home based carers respite service for adults and children

#### PURPOSE OF REPORT:

Containing exempt information defined in paragraph 14 of Part 4 of Schedule 12A of the Local Government Act, 1972 (as amended), namely information relating to the financial affairs of any particular person (including the authority holding that information). Transparency in the conduct of local authority business is desirable; however, personal financial information will be discussed and considered. Consequently it is considered; the public interest in maintaining the exemption outweighs the public interest in disclosing information by virtue of which the meeting is likely not to be open to the public during its consideration.

In accordance with the Council's Scheme of Delegation, this report has been prepared to accompany the intended officer decision of the Group Director, Community & Children's Services.

To seek approval to progress with the re-tender of Homebased respite service for adults and children.

### DELEGATED DECISION:

It was AGREED to put the carers respite service for both adults and children out to tender.

The contract length will be for 2½ years with a 1 plus 1 year extension option.
