#### 1. DECISION MADE:

## Agreed -

- To note the current operating position of the Rhondda Heritage Park, in respect of visitor numbers, the quality of the visitor experience, the condition of the facility
- 2. That the Rhondda Heritage Park is a key element of the Council's Tourism offer, recognising the potential economic, social and community benefits that the Rhondda Heritage Park offers the County Borough, and confirms that the Rhondda Heritage Park has a long term future, under the management of the Council
- To invest £500,000 in improving the visitor offer, which will include a new visitor ride simulator, with the improvements being introduced on a phased basis over the next nine months, funded through available Council resources
- 4. To explore opportunities with private and not for profit organisations to make an investment in and to operate the cafe and children's play areas, similar to the arrangements that operate at the National Lido of Wales
- 5. To authorise the Chief Executive to change the management and staffing arrangements of the Rhondda Heritage Park to reflect the proposed changes to the delivery of the visitor offer
- 6. To initiate an application for Lottery Heritage Funding to undertake improvement restoration and development of Rhondda Heritage Park, seeking investment in the region of £2.5m. This will be the second phase of the investment programme and in addition to lottery funding, opportunities for other external funding sources will also be considered to compliment the application.
