- 1. To Note that no objections, or comments were received in response to the publication of the statutory notice to progress this proposal;
- 2. To implement the proposal to close Cwmaman Infants' and Glynhafod Junior Schools and open a new Community Primary School for Cwmaman in a new school building that will be constructed for this purpose. The new school will open on 1st September 2018.
- 3. To note that a separate report on funding arrangements will be submitted to full Council in due course.

2. REASON FOR THE DECISION BEING MADE:

• The need to advise Members of the outcome of the recent publication of a statutory notice in respect of a proposal to close Cwmaman Infants' and Glynhafod Junior Schools and transfer their pupils to a new Primary school that will be created for the community, subject to parental preference, in September, 2018. It is proposed that the new school will be constructed on a currently vacant site at Glanaman Road, Cwmaman (the site of the former Fforchaman Colliery).

 This particular proposal forms part of the larger school reorganisation proposals that form our 21st Century Schools Programme for Rhondda Cynon Taf.
