**1 DECLARATION OF INTEREST**

**REPORT OF THE GROUP DIRECTOR, COMMUNITY & CHILDREN’S SERVICES CONTAINING EXEMPT INFORMATION**

**3 CHILD PRACTICE REVIEW REPORT**

In his report, the Group Director, Community & Children’s Services informed the Board of an Extended Child Practice Review undertaken by the Cwm Taf Safeguarding Children Board.

The Board was informed that the review process was very much focused on achieving positive outcomes for children and young people through learning lessons to improve multi agency safeguarding practice. The guidance includes different types of reviews, concise and extended as well as multi agency practitioner forums.

At the meeting, the Board Members were presented with the individual Extended Child Practice Review Report (CTSCB 02/2013) and introduced to Ms. Barbara Firth, one of the Independent Reviewers, involved.

The Chair then invited Ms. Firth to provide the Board with a brief outline of circumstances resulting in the Review, which focused on the period between 3<sup>rd</sup> October 2011 and 15<sup>th</sup> March 2013 together with details of the practice and organisational learning outcomes arising from the case and actions for Cwm Taf Safeguarding Children Board and its member agencies.

Following consideration of the report, it was **RESOLVED** to note the contents of the report and acknowledge that next week, the Review report would be placed on the Council's website
