"This Council calls for the development of plans to support Local Carbon Vehicle (LCV) infrastructure in Rhondda Cynon Taf by:

- Establishing a Working Group to look at the development of this infrastructure which will report back to Cabinet key recommendations.
- Lobby the UK and Welsh Government to fund the delivery of this technology to support future public demand and wider environmental benefits of LCV.

There is currently no public LCV charging infrastructure in Rhondda Cynon Taf, with limited availability across Wales. The UK Government has outlined plans to ban petrol and diesel vehicles by 2040. It is therefore vital that the development of infrastructure begins to cater for future public demand".
