## This Council acknowledges:

- The historic commitments made at the 2015 United Nations Climate Change Conference in Paris towards the future of renewable energy;
- Our responsibility to help secure an environmentally sustainable future for our residents and in relation to the global effects of man-made climate change;
- That air pollution increases the risk of lung cancer, it can worsen existing lung conditions and stunt the growth of children's lungs;
- That climate action is not an inhibitor of economic growth but rather a driver of it, and additional benefits of the development of green industries include the potential to capitalise on the objectives of the Cardiff Capital Region City Deal, in creating well-paid, high-skilled employment locally, regionally and nationally; better health and well being and financial savings to residents and businesses in the short and longer term.

In light of this, this council therefore resolves to:

- Match the ambitions of the UK100 Agreement through pledging to achieve 100% clean energy across Rhondda Cynon Taf Council's full range of functions by 2050;
- Work in partnership with our residents and business community to deliver against the commitments made nationally and internationally at the 2015 Paris Summit;
- Turn these commitments into reality through developing a `route map` to a sustainable future, working together with local business, educational and residential communities as part of an integrated approach to a shared sustainable future"
- (b) To consider the under-mentioned Notice of Motion standing in the names of County Borough Councillors J.James, L.Hooper, M.Diamond and K.LJones:-

"This Council strongly disagrees with the decision made by the Welsh Labour Government, propped up by Plaid Cymru to remove the Right to Buy scheme from social housing tenants across Wales.

Since its introduction in 1981 by the then Conservative Government, the Right to Buy scheme has allowed approximately 130,000 people to buy their council/housing

association homes across Wales. Not only has this given thousands of families the stability and certainty provided by owning their own home, but has also been a vehicle for social mobility.

This Council believes that no matter your background or where you live, you should be given the chance to own your own home. We deplore this retrograde step taken by the Welsh Government, which is indicative of its low aspirations for social housing tenants in Rhondda Cynon Taf and across Wales as a whole".
