**1. PURPOSE OF THE REPORT**

The purpose of the report is to update Members on relevant issues, with regard to

- **the Licensing Act 2003**
- **the Gambling Act 2005**

**2. RECOMMENDATION**

**3. BACKGROUND**

Members will be aware that a quarterly meeting is convened to review and discuss the implementation and progress of the Licensing Act 2003, together with any ancillary matters arising from responsibilities with which this particular Committee is charged.

Such ancillary matters include the Gambling Act 2005. (There may also be ancillary matters arising from the impact of the Smoke-Free Premises Regulations, which have the potential to affect all licensed premises).

#### 4. **LICENSING ACT 2003**

##### 4.1 **Application Process**

Applications received since the last update (**30th March 2015 to 12th July 2015**) are as follows:-

There is a noticable trend of an increase of all application types for this period, including TEN's. However, having analysed the TENs submitted for the period, there are no particular concerns. A significant number relate to outdoor events, which reflects the seasonal demand and it is pleasing to note the increased use of the TEN by various community groups.

The Morning Star has not traded as a public house since May 2013, when the premises was converted to a guest house and licensable activity ceased. However the Premises Licence has remained in force.

Unfortunately, during the period of trading as a guest house the premise was the source of significant anti social behaviour, nuisance and violent disorder caused by residents of the business, which required frequent Police intervention.

This culminated in a serious assault and a fatality at the premises which resulted in the service of a Closure Order and complete cessation of all activity. There was significant concern voiced by the community in respect of the premise and its business profile, which it was considered had had a detrimental impact on the community in which it traded.

Liaison with the owner of the building confirmed that the Premises Licence continued to have effect, but the future use of the building and potential business use had yet to be determined.

Several multi agency meetings were held with the owner of the building, in order to determine a way forward in respect of its future use, which would be acceptable to partner agencies and the community.

However, there was concern that in the absence of a robust business plan, the premises would present a risk to the community should it recommence trading as a licensed premises. Having failed to secure appropriate reassurance by the submission of such a business plan, the Police initiated a review of the Premises Licence, relying on the evidence gathered to support the Closure Order.

Having considered the evidence presented, the owner of the premises chose to surrender the Premises Licence. (As a result the Review application was withdrawn.)

The Closure order remains in force up to 20th September 2015, where NO ACCESS to the premises is permitted by any person.

The Community Safety Team continues to liaise with the owner, with a view to bringing the premises back into use. Currently there are tentative plans for a conversion to residential flats, (intended for sale), but proposals have yet to be granted the required permissions in order to proceed.

Should the premises be sold, any prospective owner would be required to apply for a new Premises Licence, which would be determined having regard to all relevant circumstances at that time.

## **4.5 Compliance & Enforcement**

### **(i) Prosecutions**

### **(iii) Test Purchasing**

Trading Standards Officers conducted 12 test purchases in the period, with no sales reported. This is again a very positive outcome, where it is considered that the pro active interventions undertaken are contributing to effective control. Officers have undertaken or contributed to the following interventions for the period:-

- Business advice to 50 premises;
- Attendance at meeting of Aberdare licensees to address alcohol related anti social behaviour in Aberdare town centre;
- Advice /guidance at Personal Licensee training courses;
- Multi agency meeting at Llantwit Fardre RFC to address issues re alcohol related anti social behaviour, proxy sales and underage drinking;
- Liaison with Drug Aid Cymru regarding the launch of 'Drink Wise, Age Well' in respect dangers of illicit alcohol;
- Mediation meeting with Beddau RFC regarding complaints issues re alcohol related anti social behaviour.

Officers are also able to report a successful prosecution of persons involved with the management of Ponty Convenience Store in respect of sales of cigarettes to young persons. (Members will note prosecution details contained in the summary report in respect of further offences in respect of alcohol sales.)

### **(iv) Partnership Working**

#### **(i) Licensee Training**

A summary of the outcomes of the licensee training delivered in April, is reproduced for information as **Appendix 1C**

It is pleasing to note that of 61 delegates, 60 passes were achieved. Whilst it is difficult at this time to assess the outcome of the training and its impact, it is anticipated that the skills gained will be retained in local trade premises and improve general awareness and capability. It was certainly well received by candidates and reproduced below are several comments which were made on the feedback sheets, which may be of interest to Members:-

- ***'RCT provided this course and it is unusual to find a Council that is actively helping business within their economic area - well done RCT***
- ***Clearer understanding , more confidence and improved skills; I found the info regarding forged ID very useful too - previously only asked for driving licence and/or passport; I now know about 3rd option & PASS hologram;***
- ***I will use this everyday and pass knowledge of this onto my work colleagues;***
- ***I learnt a lot about my job in bar work. I didn't have no knowledge until I come to this course;***
- ***It will be implemented in my future actions working in the shop. I am considering applying for a Personal Licence for future responsibilities; surprised how much I learned!***
- ***It will help me help my staff to become more structured & responsible Bar persons;***
- ***This will help me progress my role at work for future opportunities***

#### **(v) Premises Inspection & Infringements**

59 premises were inspected in the last period, (primarily category A&B) and the programme continues utilising revised assessment format.

A summary of infringements arising from inspection is reproduced as **Appendix 1D**.

Whilst the majority of non- compliance identified is of a minor nature, there continue to be instances where officers identify an absent DPS, or the departure of the licensee where there has been a failure to communicate this to the Licensing Authority. There is an example recently where a local restaurant was required to cease alcohol sales due to absent DPS and this clearly has a significant impact on the business. The approach of the Team is to 'engage compliance' and Officers always provide immediate advice & guidance with a view to reinstating licensable activity as quickly as possible.

### 4.3 Recovery of Annual Fees

**At the time of preparing this report, summary figures are not available and further comment will be made at the meeting.**

Members will be aware that Officers have authority to suspend licences where Annual fees remain unpaid , (subject to certain criteria.) A review of activity up to 12th July 2015 confirms that 13 Premises Licences are currently suspended. However, 12 of the premises are no longer trading, ( for a variety of reasons, such as change of ownership) and therefore there is limited impact to the suspension. In respect of such premises debt recovery action has also been initiated.

There is one premises currently suspended, where trading is continuing and a recent test purchase confirms that licensable activity, (retail sale of alcohol) is continuing contrary to the suspension. The matter is subject to investigation and further comment will be made at a future meeting.

Whilst the ability to suspend Premises Licences is welcomed, the process requires considerable resource to implement which is not always cost effective. However it is not considered appropriate to allow such fees to be written off. As a result, Officers have adopted an early intervention strategy where potential suspensions are targeted by officers and licensees encouraged to make payment. This has proved successful in reducing the number of suspensions required and also the resource necessary to maintain compliance.

## 5.3 Enforcement

There are no enforcement issues to report for this period.

### Gambling Licensing Policy Review 2016-2018

Members are advised that the Gambling Policy Statement is scheduled for review, (statutory requirement), where the revised policy has to be adopted for implementation in January 2016.

At the time of preparing this report, the review process has commenced with a survey being undertaken of primary gambling facilities in the Borough.

The Gambling Commission are advocating that local policy statements be reviewed, with a particular reference to revised Codes of Practice, which promote an enhanced social responsibility code.

There is a statutory requirement that applicants/licensees undertake local risk assessments as part of the application process, which takes effect April 2016. (The format is similar to that of the 'operating schedule' in Licensing Act 2003, which should have regard to the local environment.)

In advance of this, Licensing Authorities are encouraged to have regard to the revised social responsibility code within their new policy statements.

As indicated in previous reports, the licensed trade in this sector is very well regulated, where complaint/enforcement issues are minimal. Consequently it is anticipated that the current policy will need minimal changes, in so far as any legislative changes need to be accommodated.



A further report will be made to the next meeting of this Committee to present the revised policy document for consultation.

## **6 Recovery of Annual Fees**

As a result of the static nature of the trade, there is little change to the position, where 100% recovery of annual fees is the standard, primarily due to the robust provisions contained within the legislation which allow for withdrawal of the licence/permit for non-payment of appropriate fees.
