

**Sport RCT**  
**Terms and Conditions for School Fund (“T&Cs”)**

1. When submitting an application schools enter in to an agreement with Sport RCT in regards to their proposed project.
2. An application may be supported in whole or in part. If an application is supported in part then the Sport RCT offer letter will outline exactly which elements of the application have been approved.
3. If the application is approved, schools will receive an offer letter from Sport RCT.
4. The offer of grant funds made to you in the Sport RCT offer letter is made subject to these T&Cs and will be valid for acceptance by you for a period of 28 days.
5. You must indicate acceptance of the Offer by signing and dating the offer letter form and returning it to Sport RCT. Acceptance will occur only upon Sport RCT’s receipt of the signed form. No other method of acceptance will be effective or accepted by Sport RCT.
6. If the application is rejected, schools will receive a rejection letter from Sport RCT with a reason explaining why the application has not been supported. This rejection will not inhibit schools from applying again in the future.
7. Once a successful grant application has been accepted by a school, Sport RCT will arrange for items/services to be purchased. Sport RCT are unable to release grant funds in cash to schools, so instead Sport RCT will purchase the desired items/services and have them delivered to the school directly.
8. The amount of the Grant Funds detailed in the Offer Letter is the maximum amount Sport RCT will pay for the Project.
9. The funds Sport RCT distributes as grants are received from Sport Wales, following funding from the Welsh Assembly Government or the National Lottery.
10. The Recipient shall:-
  - a. use the Grant Funds for the purpose set out in the Offer Letter,
  - b. supply Sport RCT with reports on the progress of the Project as are requested by Sport RCT from time to time together with any such reports stipulated in the Offer Letter;
  - c. monitor the success of the Project and provide Sport RCT with any information reasonably required to satisfy Sport RCT that the Project is being undertaken properly and in accordance with the terms of the Offer Letter;
  - d. permit Sport RCT to carry out monitoring or evaluation visits to the Project and the Recipient will co-operate fully with Sport RCT in such regard;
  - e. ensure that all outstanding monitoring and reporting requirements in respect of the Project have been complied prior to submitting any future application for funding in respect of any other project. No future application for grant funding will be considered by Sport RCT if there are any outstanding monitoring or reporting requirements;
11. For the duration of the Project the Recipient will comply with all legislation and other laws, ensuring health and safety, promoting equal opportunities, preventing discrimination of any sort whatsoever and in ensuring the protection of children, young people and vulnerable adults.
