

Do you know how to protect your children from Carbon Monoxide (CO) poisoning?

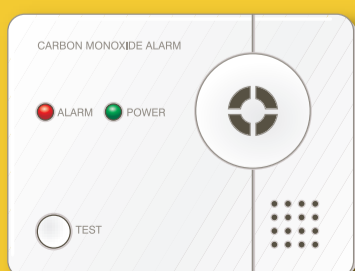


Carbon Monoxide (CO) remains the biggest cause of accidental death by poisoning in the UK
