**PROPOSED SPEED REDUCTION MEASURES  
HIGH STREET MOUNTAIN ASH  
STATEMENT OF REASONS**

A large section of High Street is already subject to a 20mph speed limit and has speed reduction measures in place. In 2013 a scheme was developed to extend the existing 20mph speed limit further into High Street however no physical measures were introduced. Following concerns raised by residents regarding vehicle speed, proposals have been developed to introduce speed reduction measures in the section of High Street which currently has no physical measures.

It is considered that these measures are necessary in order to reduce vehicle speed and improve road safety for all road users.

**SCHEDULE**

- 1 Speed Cushions to be provided in sets of 2 (minimum height: 25mm and no higher than 100mm, length: 1900mm – 3700mm; width: 1900mm maximum) at the following locations;**
  - a Outside No 75 High Street, Mountain Ash
  - b Outside the common boundary of No's 82 and 84 High Street, Mountain Ash.

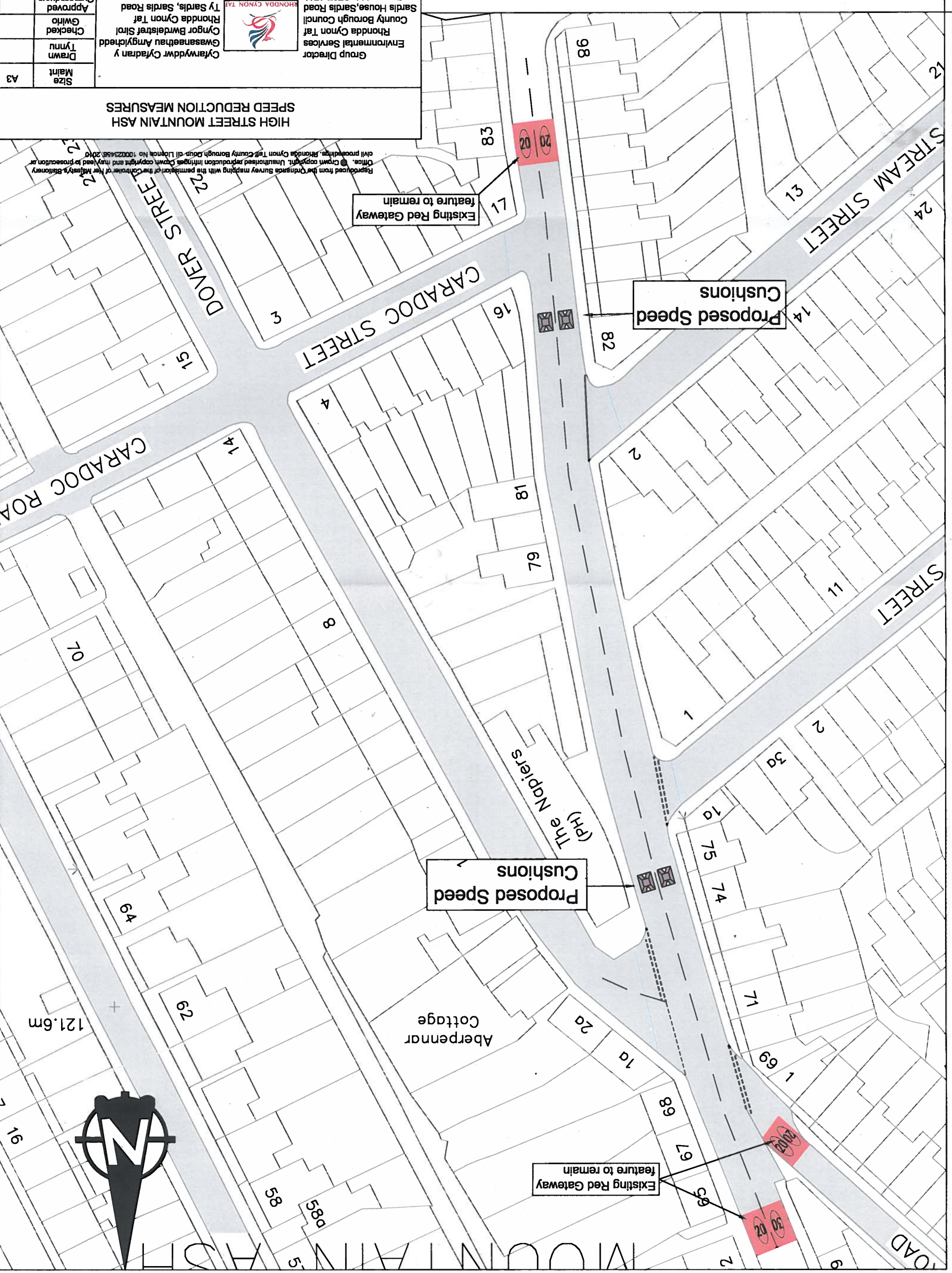
