
AGREED:

To authorise £4,000 funding support for each town centre to ensure the success of each event in 2016. This is in addition to any other monies contributed by the Forums/Groups/Chambers of Trade – i.e. market stall income, Communities First monies, etc.

That Rhondda Cynon Taf Council would provide funding to cover the total cost of all road closures required to facilitate the operations of each town centre Christmas event.

That funding will be provided to each town centre forum or in the case of Pontypridd the Business Improvement District body to consider the best arrangements for supporting the local economy in the run up to Christmas 2016


