**Agreed –**

- That in accordance with the Local Authorities (Calculation of Council Tax Base) (Wales) Regulations 1995, the amount calculated by the Council as its net tax base for the financial year ended 31<sup>st</sup> March 2016, shall be £73,297.81
- That for each area of the County Borough, the 2015/16 tax base for Council Tax setting purposes, shall be that shown within appendix 1 of the report
- To set the level of discount at:-
  - 0% - for those properties falling within Class A and Class B of the prescribed Classes of Dwellings Order
  - 50% - for those properties falling within Class C of the Prescribed Classes of Dwellings Order.

**2. REASON FOR THE DECISION BEING MADE:**

- The need to formally set the Council tax for the financial year ending 31<sup>st</sup> March 2016, in accordance with the requirements of the Local Government Finance Act 1992 (as amended) and reaffirm the level of discount applicable to the properties falling under the Council Tax (Prescribed Class of Dwelling) (Wales) Regulation 1998, as amended (relating to second homes and long term unoccupied and unfurnished properties).
