REPORT OF THE TREASURER

2015/16 BUDGET SETTING APPROVAL PROCESS

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1. <u>PURPOSE OF REPORT</u>

1.1 To seek final approval of the 2015/16 revenue budget for the Central South Consortium (CSC) Joint Committee.

2. <u>RECOMMENDATIONS</u>

It is recommended that Members:

- 2.1 Note the revised contribution levels for each Local Authority following the publication of the 'Final Local Government Revenue and Capital Settlement 2015-16' by the Welsh Government.
- 2.2 Report the decision of their home Councils on the approval of the CSC budget for 2015/16.

3. BACKGROUND

- 3.1 On the 17th December 2014 the Treasurer of the Central South Consortium presented the Joint Committee with its proposed budget for 2015/16. Members were requested to seek approval of the budget and the required contributions from their home Council and to report the decision back to this Joint Committee meeting.
- 3.2 The apportionment of contributions is based on information published by the Welsh Government in their annual 'Local Government Revenue and Capital Settlement' document. The final version of this document was not available when the reports for the December Joint Committee meeting

were distributed, therefore provisional information was used to calculate the contributions. The final figures are included in the table below:
