REPORT OF THE DIRECTOR OF LEGAL AND DEMOCRATIC SERVICES

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1. PURPOSE OF THE REPORT

To provide Members of the Health & Wellbeing Scrutiny Committee with an updated Work Programme for the 2016/2017 Municipal Year.

3. BACKGROUND

- 3.1 There is a requirement to devise and publish a Work Programme for each of the Council's Scrutiny Committees as set out in Part 4 of the Constitution, (Overview and Scrutiny Procedure Rules). Each Committee is responsible for setting and agreeing its own Work Programme; however, the Overview and Scrutiny Committee has a role in co-ordinating the work of the four thematic Scrutiny Committees and ensuring that the work of each of these committees is effective.
- 3.2 Members are reminded of the terms of reference for the Committee in respect of scrutinising services which support the Health & Wellbeing of our communities. The Committee considers adult social services as well as other factors which contribute to the health & wellbeing of the County Borough such as Leisure Services, Housing and Public Health & Wellbeing.

4. PROPOSED WORK PROGRAMME

- 4.1 In taking on board Members' views as expressed at the last meeting of the Health & Wellbeing Scrutiny Committee (8th September 2016) and following further discussions with the Chair & Vice Chair, in conjunction with the relevant Officers, the following four topics have been included on the Work Programme, to include the pre scrutiny of the Learning Disability Commissioning Strategy in November 2016:-
 - Commissioned Services 'Home Care' (December 2016)
 - Public Health and Protection 'Food Standards Agency (FSA) full audit inspection report and action plan' (November 2016)
 - Trading Standards Trading Standards 'Protecting Vulnerable People' (February 2017)
 - Learning Difficulties Commissioning Strategy Pre scrutiny (November 2016)
- 4.2 As referred to earlier, the proposed timetable for the delivery of the Work Programme is attached at Appendix 1. When appropriate, Members will need to make a judgement on the preferred method of scrutiny e.g. via full Scrutiny Committee meetings or via 'working groups', that report back to the full Scrutiny Committee.
- 4.3 In addition to the above considerations, during the year the Committee could also receive requests from the Executive or other committees e.g. Council, Audit Committee or Overview & Scrutiny, to consider a particular issue and therefore an element of flexibility also needs to be applied to the Work Programme
