Review of Licensing Act 2003 & Gambling Act 2005

1. <u>PURPOSE OF THE REPORT</u>

The purpose of the report is to update Members on relevant issues, with regard to

- the Licensing Act 2003
- the Gambling Act 2005

2. <u>RECOMMENDATION</u>

Members are requested to: -

- (i) note the contents of the report in respect of the Licensing Act 2003 which has been provided for information;
- (ii) note the contents of the report in respect of the **Gambling Act 2005**, which has been provided for information.

3. BACKGROUND

Members will be aware that a quarterly meeting is convened to review and discuss the implementation and progress of the Licensing Act 2003, together with any ancillary matters arising from responsibilities with which this particular Committee is charged.

Such ancillary matters include the Gambling Act 2005. (There may also be ancillary matters arising from the impact of the Smoke-Free Premises Regulations, which have the potential to affect all licensed premises).

4. LICENSING ACT 2003

4.1 Application Process

Applications received since the last update (21st December 2015 to 20th March 2016) are as follows:-

Matters to note this period include a significant reduction in the TEN's applications submitted than the last period albeit this is likely to reflect the time of year with a decline after the busy Christmas period. Analysis of the TEN's applications indicate 27 were for Private Members Clubs, 21 for existing premises and 11 for community events. Many of the TEN's provided relate to charitable events and fund raising for clubs and a small number for the Easter Bank Holiday weekend.

4.5 Compliance & Enforcement

(i) **Prosecutions**

There has been one completed prosecution under the Licensing Act 2003 in the period. Mr Simon Madley of Fagin's Ale and Chop House, Cardiff Road, Taffs Well pleaded guilty to two Offences under the Licensing Act 2003 following breaches of a licence condition relating to music audibility. Mr Madley also pleaded to two offences under the Environmental Protection Act 1990, in respect of breach of Abatement Notice issued against Fagin's Ale and Chop House.

(ii) Test Purchasing

Licensing Officers have conducted test purchases at Four Takeaway establishments following concerns that they were trading illegally i.e selling hot food after 11pm without a Premises Licence. Following successful test purchases at each premises, one is currently subject to an infringement report, the three other premises received warning/advice letters.

(iii) Premises Inspection & Infringements

248 premises were inspected in the last period, this total also reflects a desk top exercise conducted for educational / community premises with no alcohol facilities.

A summary of infringements arising from inspection is reproduced as **Appendix 1B.**

A total of 3 Section 19 Notices under the Criminal Justice and Police Act 2001 have been issued in the period following the identification of Non compliant CCTV. Officers will ensure that the premises are reinspected to verify compliance with the relevant conditions.

The Licensing Authority acting in its role as responsible authority has brought a Premises Licence review of one on licensed premises in the Ton Pentre area as a result of unlicensed door staff engaged at the premise.

(iv) Advice and Guidance

Cynon Valley

As part of its early intervention approach a meeting was held with South Wales Police, Licensing Authority and major pub chain, concerning one of its premises in Aberdare. The meeting was arranged following a number of incidents at the premises prior to the Christmas period. South Wales Police made a number of recommendations to help improve practices at the premises and it was agreed that the company concerned would implement the same in conjunction with the premises tenant.

A follow up meeting was subsequently held, where it was agreed that there had been improvement at the premises which was attributed to improved management of the premises, an increase in Police presence in the area, upgraded CCTV system and the use of body cams by door supervisors which are rented from the authority's CCTV section.

After receiving information from the Youth Offending Service of proxy sales taking place in Aberdare Town Centre on Friday evenings, CCTV footage was requested from two town centre off licences. The footage supplied and viewed by Licensing Officers. No offences were detected, however information was passed to the Trading Standards Department concerning the sale of cigarettes.

A meeting was held with officers of a local Rugby club following information from the Youth Offending Team of a function being held at the club which resulted in a number of young people remaining outside the club unable to gain entry.

It was established that the event was a fund raiser for the youth team with strict entry of ticket only and the ages of 16 to 19. Officers checked the CCTV footage for the event, it was apparent that a number of young people were refused entry by the door staff.

It appeared that the ticketing arrangements in place for the event were flawed which led to additional photocopied tickets being distributed to young persons. Advice has been provided to the club in order to prevent a reoccurence.

Rhondda

Licensing Officers together with a representative of the Security Industry Authority (SIA) visited a licensed premises in Ton Pentre, following information that an unlicensed door supervisor was working at the premises. Subsequent investigation revealed that two door supervisors at the premises were unlicensed. An update for Members will be provided at the meeting.

Licensing Officers visited a licensed premises to advise of the implications of holding a Premises Licence and a Club Premises Certificate at the establishment.

A joint visit was made by local authority and Police Licensing Officers to a licensed premises to provide advice on amending his licence via a minor variation to remove unenforceable conditions and re-word some conditions.

Taff Area

Licensing Officers met with a private members club following requests for advice on applying for a Premises Licence at the premises. Two further club premises were visited with South Wales Police Officers following incidents at their premises.

Following a complaint from a member of the public and subsequent premises inspection, an on licensed premises has met with Officers from the Police, Licensing Authority and Trading Standards concerning youth events /discos. Written advice was provided and an offer of free training for bar staff concerning proof of age was extended.

Advice and guidance was provided to the Royal Mint concerning the licensing of its new visitor centre in Llantrisant.

Safeguarding training was provided during Pontypridd Pub watch which was well received by Members.

Advice has been provided to another private members club concerning bottles and glasses being allowed to leave the premises and compliance generally with licence conditions.

Licensing Officers have also conducted a joint visit with Trading Standards Officers to licensed premises. Officers identified initial non compliance with licence conditions at one licensed premises in Pontypridd. The premises was revisited, guidance provided and improvement in respect of compliance noted.

Officers have ensured that fees for Premises Licences are paid promptly and action instigated in terms of Suspension where appropriate. This is reflected in the level of outstanding fees as detailed above.

A review of activity up to 20th March 2016, shows that several Premises Licences were subject to suspension but have since paid and consequently their suspensions lifted.
