Review of Licensing Act 2003 & Gambling Act 2005	

1. PURPOSE OF THE REPORT

The purpose of the report is to update Members on relevant issues, with regard to

- **the Licensing Act 2003**
- **the Gambling Act 2005**

2. RECOMMENDATION

Members are requested to: -

- (i) note the contents of the report in respect of the **Licensing Act 2003** which has been provided for information;
- (ii) note the contents of the report in respect of the **Gambling Act 2005**, which has been provided for information.

3. BACKGROUND

Members will be aware that a quarterly meeting is convened to review and discuss the implementation and progress of the Licensing Act 2003, together with any ancillary matters arising from responsibilities with which this particular Committee is charged.

Such ancillary matters include the Gambling Act 2005. (There may also be ancillary matters arising from the impact of the Smoke-Free Premises Regulations, which have the potential to affect all licensed premises).

4. **LICENSING ACT 2003**

4.1 **Application Process**

Applications received since the last update (**25th September 2017 to 7th January, 2018**) are as follows:-

There has been an increase in the number of Temporary Event Notices (TEN's) notifications during this period which can be attributed to events for Halloween, Bonfire Night, Christmas and the New Year.

A number of Convenience Stores in the Borough utilised the TEN's process to authorise additional hours for the sale of alcohol on Christmas Day.

We are also seeing some Micro-breweries being established in the area, who are using TEN's while they consider the feasibility of applying for Premises Licences.

Analysis of the TEN's applications indicate 41 related to Private Members Clubs, 70 for existing premises licences and 34 permitted community events.

A summary of TEN's, is reproduced for Members information as **Appendix 1A**.

In accordance with the advice received in respect of data protection matters, the summaries of Personal Licences and Premises Licences issued under delegated authority are now reproduced for information as a Part II restricted item.

4.2 Contested Applications

Three contested applications have been determined since the last summary report:-

SPAR, Treherbert

The applicant was applying to extend the hours of opening. Initial objections were received by means of a residents petition, but no signatories replied to any contact from officers and failed to appear at the Hearing. The two Local Members attended the Hearing and outlined the importance of the business acting responsibly and remaining a key part of the Community. The application was granted subject to the imposition of various conditions.

Domino's

The applicant was applying for a Late Night Refreshment Licence from 23:00 - 05:00. Objections were received from South Wales Police, Licensing Authority, Environmental Health, the Local Member and a number of Residents. The application was refused and an appeal has been lodged by the applicant.

Ynyshir & District Workmen's Club and Institute

The applicant was applying for the grant of a Premises Licence, which would replace the current Club Premises Certificate. There were initial objections from a resident and a petition from a recently formed action group. The petition did not outline the reasons for the objection, and all efforts to ascertain the details of the founder of the action group failed. Neither the resident or any person linked to the petition attended the Hearing.

The application was granted subject to the imposition of various conditions.

4.3 Premises Inspection & Infringements

34 premises in the Borough were inspected in the period between 25th September 2017 and the 7th January 2017.

The relevant Performance indicator for the Licensing Team is "*the premises licences found to be broadly compliant following inspection by Licensing Officers*". Officers will consider confidence in management, compliance with licence conditions and business competency when determining the risk rating of the premises when considering whether they are broadly compliant.

Our current performance indicates that 80% of premises inspected are broadly compliant.

A summary of infringements arising from inspection is reproduced as **Appendix 1B**.

4.4 Complaints, Advice and Guidance

Cynon Valley

A number of joint visits have been conducted with Police Licensing staff to both on and off premises within the Cynon area.

On one of these joint visits an owner of an off-license was advised on the removal of drug paraphernalia displayed behind the counter.

During a routine visit to a Public House in Aberdare to discuss a complaint, it became apparent that the upstairs area had been converted into a function room without varying the license. A meeting was arranged with Responsible Authorities to discuss the possibility of a Full Variation. Meanwhile the Premises Licence Holder submitted TEN's to fulfill booking commitments over the Christmas period.

A successful fundraising evening was held at The Bute in Aberdare on 2 November which raised £1255 for the local defibrillator fund. This was match funded by Santander Bank providing enough funds for a defibrillator to be sited outside the premises.

An application was received for a new restaurant in Aberdare with an upstairs 'party room'. A meeting was arranged with the applicant after concerns were raised with some of the Responsible Authorities. The applicant then revised his application, removing the upstairs area.

A complaint about possible under age sales in a convenience store in Penrhiwceiber led to a transfer of Premises Licence Holder and a change of Designated Premises Supervisor.

Rhondda

A Committee Hearing was held on 13 November to determine the application to extend the opening hours of Spar in Treherbert. The Licensing committee 's decision was to permit the extended hours with conditions attached.

Advice was provided to an individual who is considering applying for a premises licence at a property in Penygraig. To date no application has been submitted.

An anonymous complaint was received regarding several premises facilitating illegal betting in their premises. All premises have been contacted and informed of the legislation regarding this activity. The Gambling Commission has also been informed.

A visit was made to a premises in Tonypany by the area Licensing Officer and South Wales Police. An incident had occurred at the premises that the police were investigating and the visit brought to light that the Designated Premises Supervisor (DPS) was absent from the premises. An application was submitted later that day to change the DPS.

Pc Jackie Whittle is the new Police Licensing Officer and her allocated area is the Rhondda. Pc Whittle is a welcome addition to the Police Licensing Team and has attended the recent Licensing Sub Committees.

Officers have attended Pubwatches in the Rhondda in the period and they continue to be very well attended and proactive in dealing with any identified issues in the area.

Officers have facilitated multi agency meetings that have resulted in the smooth running of an outdoor event in the Wattstown area.

Officers have conducted a joint premises inspection with the Gambling Commission in the Porth area, all parts of the inspection were found to be satisfactory and further checks will be made in the near future.

Taff Area

Officers have met with a potential applicant for a Micropub in the Pontyclun area for pre application advice. The applicant has had several TEN's over the past couple of months and these have been problem free with no complaints arising.

Officers have attended at a private members club in the Llantwit Fardre area to give advice and guidance to the bar staff of the premises at the request of the Committee.

Officers have attended Pubwatches in Pontypridd and Treforest throughout the period. The Pubwatches continue to be well attended and proactive, when appropriate, in the exclusion of disorderly patrons.

Complaints have been reported for 3 separate premises in the Treforest area. The local area officer has conducted inspections with Licensing Police Officers and provided full advice to the Premises Licence Holders. The local residents in all cases are reporting improvements.

Complaints have been received regarding a Licensed Premises in the Llantrisant area. The local area officer has conducted a visit with Police Licensing Officers to meet with the new DPS, providing full advice regarding the history of the premises and reminding the DPS of the conditions on their licence. The resident has reported improvements and the complaint has been closed.

An Off Licence shop was found to be in breach of a number of conditions on their licence. A meeting was held between the Licensing Authority, South Wales Police and the Licensee of the premises. Due to family commitments the premises licence has been transferred and the DPS has been Varied.

Pre Application advice has been given to a premises in the Taffs Well area, which subsequently resulted in a Full Variation application being submitted.

4.5 Community Alcohol Partnership (CAP)

The Community Alcohol Partnership has continued to be a success in Porth and a full evaluation is due to be carried out in March. An analysis of Anti Social Behaviour in the Porth has indicated a reduction in Anti Social Behaviour incidents by 28%.

Due to the success in Porth we have decided to implement a Community Alcohol Partnership in Pontypridd. The initial surveys will be conducted at the end of January with the launch planned for the beginning of March.

4.6 Alcohol/Gambling Newsletter

The November edition of the Alcohol/Gambling Newsletter was distributed. The newsletter focussed on crime prevention, the "Ask Angela" initiative, gambling, Police Christmas campaign, TEN's and the forthcoming Six Nations fixtures. A copy of the newsletter is reproduced for Members information as **Appendix 1C**. The newsletter continues to be received positively by the Licensees.

4.7 Training

- (i) A multi agency training event took place at The Blueberry Inn, Pontypridd on the 24th October. The training focussed around SIA trained door supervisors and the role they played in ensuring we have a vibrant and safe Night Time Economy.

During the training there was an emphasis on the important role that front line SIA staff carry out with an emphasis to develop good working relationships with the police and other enforcement agencies. The training was also an opportunity to provide an insight into policies and procedures when enforcement agencies carry out investigations involving SIA badge holders.

Guest speakers spoke about Safeguarding, Counter Terrorism, Child Sexual Exploitation and the Security Industry Agency.

The event was a massive success and a follow up session took place on the 16th January at The Soul Suite, Pontypridd. The event was equally well attended and received as the first event. Guest speakers at this event included representatives from the SIA, South Wales Police Serious Crime Investigative Team, South Wales Police Conflict Management Training Department and Safeguarding.

Due to the success of the events, and the important messages that are conveyed during the sessions, it is the intention to run approximately two training events per year.

- (ii) Officers have attended Police Officer training days to provide an input on the Licensing Act 2003. During these sessions, it was also an opportunity to provide front line officers with information around the Licensing Department and how we can assist them in their day to day roles. The sessions have been very well received by Police Officers and two more training days have been scheduled for the 31st January and the 5th March.
- (iii) Officers attended a Night Time Economy conference, hosted by the South Wales Police and Crime Commissioner, on the 30th November. The conference provided an insight into how other authorities operate, and provided examples of best practice throughout the UK, as well as an excellent opportunity to network. It was pleasing to see that the work being done in Rhondda Cynon Taf is rated highly by Senior Officers within South Wales Police and the Crime Commissioner.

4.8 Recovery of Annual Fees

5.3 Recovery of Annual Fees
