THE PREPARATION OF THE COMMITTEE'S WORK PROGRAMME FOR 2014/15

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1. PURPOSE OF THE REPORT

The purpose of this report is to advise Members on issues for consideration when preparing a work programme for the Committee.

2. **RECOMMENDATIONS**

It is recommended that: Members:

- (i) Note the information contained within the report;
- (ii) Agree on issues, for inclusion on the Committee's Work Programme for the Municipal Year 2014/15.

3. BACKGROUND

- 3.1 There is a requirement to devise and publish a Work Programme for each of the Council's Scrutiny Committees as set out in Part 4 of the Constitution, (Overview and Scrutiny Procedure Rules). Each Committee is responsible for setting and agreeing its own Work Programme. However, the Overview and Scrutiny Committee, also has a co-ordinating role and will ensure that there is no duplication of work across the service scrutiny committees and will deliberate if necessary on any cross cutting issues.
- 3.2 The terms of reference for the Committee is to co-ordinate the work of the four service scrutiny committees and to fulfil the overview & scrutiny role in relation to "all Council" cross cutting themes which cut across the terms of reference of the four service scrutiny committees.

3.3 Issues for consideration are set out in Section 4 below. However, it is important that all Members have the opportunity to consider and put forward items for consideration and it should be noted that the draft work programme is only provided as a basis for discussion.

4. ISSUES FOR CONSIDERATION

4.1 As well as specific issues, which the Committee may wish to identify for future scrutiny, Members will need to consider the inclusion of regular or on-going items such as

Financial and Performance Management – the Committee receives the feedback from the quarterly financial and performance management exception reports which have been presented to the four service scrutiny committees along with the performance of the Action Plan relating to the improvement priority scrutinised specifically by the Overview & Scrutiny Committee, namely, Medium Term Service Planning.

The Committee will also receive feedback from the four service scrutiny committees and review overall progress in respect of those areas which are included in the Council's Outcome Agreement with the Welsh Government.

Budget Consultation Process – The Committee is involved in the annual revenue budget setting consultation process.

Corporate Plan and Annual Delivery Plan — Working groups of each scrutiny committee will play a part in reviewing the Council's Annual Delivery Report which is an assessment of performance for the previous financial year. This will take place in the autumn. Members will be aware that the scrutiny working groups met in April to provide feedback on the draft improvement priority action plans which form the Corporate Plan and subject to review this process will take place once again in the spring of 2015 in preparation for the 2015/16 Corporate Plan. The Overview & Scrutiny Committee will receive feedback from this process and well as having its own working group in relation to the Medium Term Service Planning action plan.

Annual Report – The Procedure Rules for Overview and Scrutiny contained within the Council's Constitution requires that an annual report be submitted to Council on the work carried out during the year.

- 4.2 **Task & Finish Groups** a scrutiny working group has recently been formed to the consider the Wales Audit Office report 'Good Scrutiny? Good Question!
- 4.3 **Local Service Board Scrutiny Working Group** this is a continuous commitment for the Committee.

- 4.4 **Welfare Reform** the Committee is yet to receive a response from the Executive to its Welfare Reform report. This will be reported to the Committee once available and updates as necessary will be provided to either the Corporate Services or Overview & Scrutiny Committee (as appropriate) in relation to the introduction of Universal Credit and the impact of the welfare reforms.
- 4.5 The introduction of Councillor Calls for Action through the Local Government (Wales) Measure 2011 also has the potential to create additional work for the Committee. However, it should be noted that the Committee has not received any Councillor Calls for Action during the last two years.
- 4.6 The Constitution requires that there is a minimum of six meetings of the Committee each year and an outline work programme is attached at Appendix 1.
- 4.7 Attached as Appendices 2a through to 2d, are the draft work programmes presented to the four service scrutiny committee. However, it should be noted that these will be updated following this first cycle of scrutiny meetings.
- 4.8 In addition to the above considerations, the Committee could receive requests from the Executive or other committees eg Council or Audit Committee to consider a particular issue. The Cabinet Work Programme is attached for information at Appendix 3.

5. SCRUTINY OF CRIME & DISORDER

5.1 When considering its work programme, Members will need to keep in mind the Committee's responsibilities under Sections 19 and 20 of the Police and Justice Act 2006 and the requirement to hold at least one meeting of the Crime & Disorder Committee during the year. Members are asked to consider whether there are any specific areas of work which they would like to undertake.

6. KEY QUESTIONS FOR MEMBERS

- 6.1 Attached at Appendix 1 for consideration is the draft work programme for the Committee for 2014/15.
- 6.2 The Committee is asked to consider whether it is in agreement with the proposals and whether there are any other issues Members would wish to see included.
