245 <u>APPLICATION RECOMMENDED FOR APPROVAL INVOLVING A</u> <u>PUBLIC SPEAKER</u>

Application No.13/0558 – Construction of 4 no. 4 bedroom dwellings (amended plans received 12/03/14) - Land to the rear of 58-60 Rhiw'r Ddar, Taffs Well

In accordance with adopted procedures, the Committee received Mr.T.Bevan (Objector), who was afforded five minutes to present his comments on the above-mentioned application.

Following consideration of the proposal, it was **RESOLVED** that as Members were minded to refuse the application contrary to the Officer's recommendation because they considered the area should be retained as the only green space on the Rhiw'r Ddar housing estate, the matter be deferred to the next appropriate meeting of the Development Control Committee for a report from the Service Director, Planning, if necessary in consultation with the Director, Legal & Democratic Services, upon the strengths and weaknesses of taking a decision contrary to recommendation.

246 DEFERRED APPLICATION INVOLVING PUBLIC SPEAKERS

Application No.13/1004 – Proposed residential development, local centre, car parking and access – Bryncae Industrial Estate, Bridgend Road, Llanharan

(Note: County Borough Councillor J.Rosser declared a personal interest in respect of the above-mentioned application stating – "My husband is employed by the applicant as an office caretaker".

The Committee considered the report of the Service Director, Planning which recommended approval of the application subject to a Section 106 agreement and conditions.

The Development Control Manager reported orally on "late" letters received from:

- Mr.H.Roberts, who had addressed the Committee earlier, providing local residents comments on the proposed development
- Three members of the same family residing at Coychurch Road, Pencoed objecting to the proposal
- The occupier of 44 Terrys Way, Llanharan objecting to the proposal
- The owner of The Spar, Cowbridge Road, Pontyclun giving his views on the proposal and its impact on local businesses

Following lengthy consideration of the proposal, it was **RESOLVED** that as Members were minded to refuse the application contrary to the Officer's recommendation because they considered:

- (1) The proposed development, with the combined housing and retail elements, would significantly increase traffic movements to the detriment of highway safety for both motorists and pedestrians;
- (2) The proposed development, in particular the retail element, is contrary to the Local Development Plan adopted in 2011 as it would have a detrimental effect on the viability of the new Village Centre planned for the area;

the matter be deferred to the next appropriate meeting of the Development Control Committee for a report from the Service Director, Planning, if necessary in consultation with the Director, Legal & Democratic Services, upon the strengths and weaknesses of taking a decision contrary to recommendation.

14/0119 – three bedroom detached dwelling with garage – Land to the South East of The Royal Oak, Incline Top, Abercynon **14/0263** – Change of use from offices to 2 no. Residential units. Minor internal alterations proposed and minor external changes to form doorway and provide new external stair – 3a Church Street, Pontypridd
