Introduction



In May 2023, Rhondda Cynon Taf Council agreed to improve their Learning Disability Day Services in response to the My Day My Way Engagement.



My Day, My Way gave individuals with a learning disability and others the opportunity to share things that are important to them, and how their day could be better.

The Council have proposed a new coproduced operating model for Day Services



The new model will have three levels of support, based on individual needs:

- Community and Employment
- Maximising Community Connections
- Council's Offer



Coproduced means individuals with a learning disability and the Council have come together as equals to make decisions.



Focusing on an individual's choice and wellbeing, this model will help to keep people feeling independent with support, in their local communities.

We are now asking you to help us make some decisions about these things.

Community and Employment



At this level individuals will be supported to recognise their strengths, support networks and community support options- to maintain independence, health, and wellbeing.

This offer would be suitable for individuals with low support needs and includes:



 use of community resources such as leisure services, libraries, and open access groups to provide activities and social contacts for people within a community setting.



 Use of community resources to provide activities such as training, volunteering, and employment for people within their local community.



 Review the Council's current learning disability projects to refocus these as social enterprises or work opportunities either through Vision Products or other community settings.

Maximising Community Connections



At this level individuals will be supported to regain their independence and have opportunities to connect to their communities over time.

This offer would be suitable for individuals who have support needs and includes:



 a programme of support which helps individuals to lead on developing their own services



development of microenterprises



• pooling direct payments



supporting the community hubs.

Council's Offer



At this level individuals would be supported to access centre-based support as well as some community-based groups.



There will be a focus on an individual's health and wellbeing, with the support of multi-disciplinary teams (for example-health, care management).



This offer would be suitable for individuals with more complex health and communication needs and includes:

 person-centred communication for example, assistive technology to offer a range of choices and activities



 specialist support to help individuals move through pathways into less intensive support



 two bespoke day centres East and West, along with smaller communitybased groups.

Welsh language


