DYMA HYSBYSIAD bod Cyngor Bwrdeistref Sirol Rhondda Cynon Taf yn bwriadu gwneud Gorchymyn, ar ôl o leiaf 7 diwrnod o ddyddiad yr Hysbysiad yma, o dan Adran 14 o Ddeddf Rheoleiddio Traffig Ffyrdd 1984, fel y'i diwygiwyd gan Ddeddf Traffig Ffyrdd (Cyfyngiadau Dros Dro) 1991, a fydd yn para deunaw mis ar y mwyaf. Mae hyn yn hanfodol er mwyn gwella diogelwch ar y ffordd wrth i'r gwaith o amgylch y ffordd fynd rhagddo.

Effaith y Gorchymyn fydd:

1. **Cau Ffordd Dros Dro** - Ffordd Osgoi Aberdâr A4059, o'i gyffordd â Chylchfan Asda i'w gyffordd â Chylchfan Tinney

Hyd - Dros nos rhwng 2300 a 0600 o 6 Ionawr 2020 am 12 wythnos

Er mwyn lleihau'r effaith ar draffig, fyddwn ni ddim yn cau'r ffordd am fwy na thair noson yn olynol ar unrhyw adeg yn ystod y cyfnod o 12 wythnos

2. **Terfyn cyflymder 30mya dros dro** - A4059 Ffordd Osgoi Aberdâr, o'i gyffordd â Chylchfan Asda, i'r gogledd-orllewin am bellter o 640 metr

Hyd- o 6 Ionawr 2020 am 12 wythnos neu hyd nes y bydd y gwaith wedi'i gwblhau

Pan fydd y ffordd ar gau, bydd llwybr arall i gerbydau fel a ganlyn:


Llwybr amgen - o ochr ddeheuol y ffordd sydd ar gau, dilynwch yr A4059, Cylchfan Cwmbach, Heol y Gamlas, Heol Cwm-bach, Cylchfan Abernant, Cylchfan Ynys a'r A4059 i ochr ogleddol y ffordd sydd ar gau. Y gwrthwyneb i'r uchod yw'r llwybr i gerbydau sy'n teithio i'r cyfeiriad arall

Llwybr amgen i gerbydau sy'n uwch na 12'00" - o ochr ddeheuol y ffordd sydd ar gau, dilynwch yr A4059, Cylchfan Cwmbach, Heol y Gamlas, Heol Cwm-bach, Cylchfan Abernant, Stryd Wellington, Cylchfan Stryd Meirion a'r A4059 i ochr ogleddol y ffordd sydd ar gau. Y gwrthwyneb i'r uchod yw'r llwybr i gerbydau sy'n teithio i'r cyfeiriad arall.

(TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE AND

TEMPORARY 30MPH SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 2019

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Rhondda Cynon Taff County Borough Council intends, not less than 7 days from the date of this Notice, to make an Order under Section 14 and 88 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, which will have a maximum duration of eighteen months and are necessary to improve road safety whilst works are being carried out on or near the road.

The effect of the Order will be to: -

1. **Temporary Road Closure** - A4059 Aberdare Bypass, from its junction with the Asda Roundabout to its junction with Tinney's Roundabout

Duration - Overnight between 2300 hours and 0600 hours from 6th January 2020 for 12 weeks

To reduce the impact on traffic, there will be no more than 3 consecutive overnight closures at any time during the 12 week period

2. **Temporary 30mph speed limit** - A4059 Aberdare Bypass, from its junction with the Asda Roundabout, north westwards for a distance of 640 metres

Duration- from 6th January 2020 for 12 weeks or until such time as the works have been completed

During the road closure the alternative route for vehicles is as follows:-


Alternative route - from the southern side of the closure, prove via A4059, Cwmbach Roundabout, Canal Road, Cwmbach Road, Abernant Roundabout, Ynys Roundabout and A4059 to the northern side of the closure. For vehicles travelling in the opposite direction, reverse the directions given above

Alternative route for vehicles exceeding 12' 00" restrictions - from the southern side of the closure, proceed via A4059, Cwmbach Roundabout, Canal Road, Cwmbach Road, Abernant Roundabout, Wellington Street, Meirion Street Roundabout and A4059 to the northern side of the closure. For vehicles travelling in the opposite direction reverse the directions given above.

Access for emergency service vehicles **WILL NOT** be maintained

Access for pedestrians will be maintained
