

Atodlen 2 – Gwahardd aros ar unrhyw adeg

1. Ochr ogledd-orllewinol Clos Tyn-y-Cymer o'i gyffordd â Ffordd Caemawr i gyfeiriad y de-orllewin am bellter o 10 metr
2. Ochr dde-ddwyreiniol Clos Tyn-y-Cymer o'i gyffordd â Ffordd Caemawr i gyfeiriad y de-orllewin am bellter o 30 metr
3. Ochr ogledd-ddwyreiniol Clos Tyn-y-Cymer o ffin ddeheuol Rhif 20 i gyfeiriad y gogledd-orllewin hyd at ffin adeiladu gogledd orllewinol Rhif 22 am bellter o 39 metr
4. Ochr ogledd-ddwyreiniol Clos Tyn-y-Cymer o bwynt 16 metr i'r gogledd-orllewin o ffin adeiladu gogledd orllewinol Rhif 22 i'r gogledd-orllewin am bellter o 29 metr
5. Ochr ogledd-ddwyreiniol Clos Tyn-y-Cymer o bwynt 65 metr i gyfeiriad y gogledd-orllewin o ffin adeiladu gogledd orllewinol Rhif 22 i'r gogledd-orllewin am bellter o 18 metr
6. Ochr dde-orllewinol Clos Tyn-y-Cymer o ffin ddeheuol Rhif 2 i'r gogledd-orllewin am bellter o 117 metr

2. Introduce waiting restrictions as described in Schedule 2


Schedule 1 - Variation

1. The 'Rhondda Cynon Taff County Borough Council (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting and Loading and On Street Parking Places) (Consolidation) Order 2012' shall be varied in that the order referred to in the Schedule of Orders as "Mid Glamorgan County Council (Tynycymer Close and Unnamed Access Road, Porth) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order 1981" shall be varied by the removal of the Order in its entirety

Schedule 2 – Prohibition of waiting At Any Time

1. The north western side of Tynycymer Close from its junction with Caemawr Road south westwards for a distance of 10 metres
2. The south eastern side of Tynycymer Close from its junction with Caemawr Road south westwards for a distance of 30 metres
3. The north eastern side of Tynycymer Close from the southern boundary of No 20 north westwards to the north western building line of No 22 a distance of 39 metres
4. The north eastern side of Tynycymer Close from a point 16 metres north west of the north western building line of No 22 north westwards for a distance of 29 metres
5. The north eastern side of Tynycymer Close from a point 65 metres north west of the north western building line of No 22 north westwards for a distance of 18 metres
6. The south western side of Tynycymer Close from the southern boundary of No 2 north westwards for a distance of 117 metres
