Dear Sir/Madam,

As you may be aware, the local authority have recently consulted on proposals to introduce a zebra type crossing, prohibition of waiting any time restrictions, extend the existing 20mph speed limit and install additional traffic calming features near Ton Pentre Junior School to create a safer environment for all highway users.

Moreover, we seek to replace the existing mini roundabout on Church Road, Ton Pentre with a raised junction to decrease the speed of through traffic and reduce crossing distances for pedestrians along current desire lines. The prohibition of waiting at any time restrictions are necessary to improve the vision splay for motorists travelling from Bailey and Church Street.

396 letters were sent out during the informal consultation stage and 47 responses received. 37 responded in support with 16 including additional comments. 10 objections were received.

It was suggested during the informal consultation stage that speed cushions are easily negotiated by a heavy goods vehicle. Vertical deflections are the most effective and reliable form of speed reduction currently available. However, they must be constructed within a certain tolerance in order to comply with current design standards.

Requests were also received from residents during informal consultation for additional traffic calming features to be provided outside numbers 16/17 and 26/7 Maindy Road which have now been included. The next stage in the process will be to give a period of Public Notice of the proposals, where details of the scheme are advertised to provide opportunity for members of the public to formally raise any comments they may have. Yn ddiweddar, mae'r awdurdod lleol wedi cynnal ymgynghoriad ynglŷn â chynigion i osod croesfan (yn debyg i groesfan sebra), cyfyngiadau gwahardd aros ar unrhyw adeg, ymestyn ardal y terfyn cyflymder o 20mph, a gosod mwy o fesurau gostegu traffig wrth Ysgol Iau Tonpentre. Byddai'r mesurau yma'n arwain at amgylchedd mwy diogel i bawb sy'n defnyddio'r ffordd.

Rydyn ni hefyd yn gobeithio cael gwared ar y gylchfan fach ar Heol yr Eglwys, Tonpentre a gosod cyffordd wedi'i chodi yno. Byddai gwneud hyn yn lleihau cyflymder y traffig ac yn lleihau'r pellter croesi i gerddwyr. Mae cyfyngiadau gwahardd aros am unrhyw amser yn angenrheidiol er mwyn gwella gwelededd i fodurwyr sy'n teithio o gyfeiriad Stryd yr Eglwys a Stryd Bailey.

Cafodd 396 o lythyrau eu hanfon trwy gyfnod yr ymgynghoriad anffurfiol, a derbyniwyd 47 o ymatebion. Roedd 37 o'r ymatebion yn cefnogi'r cynlluniau, ac 16 ohonyн nhw'n cynnwys sylwadau pellach. Daeth 10 gwrrthwynebiad i law.

Yn ystod cyfnod yr ymgynghoriad anffurfiol, awgrymwyd bod modd i gerbydau nwyddau trwm negodi clustogau arafu yn rhwydd. Gwyriadau fertigol yw'r dull lleihau cyflymder mwyaf effeithiol a dibynadwy sydd ar gael. Fodd bynnag, rhaid cadw at reolau goddefiant penodol wrth eu gosod fel eu bod yn cydymffurfio â'r safonau dylunio cyfredol.

Daeth ceisiadau gan drigolion lleol i law yn ystod cyfnod yr ymgynghoriad anffurfiol i ddarparu mwy o fesurau gostegu traffig wrth rifau 16/17 a 26/7 Heol y Maendy.
