FFORDD LLANTRISANT, LLANILLTUD FAERDREF

(NEWID I'R HYSBYSIAD CROESFAN I GERDDWYR) 2022

DATGANIAD O'R RHESYMAU

Mae cymuned Llanilltud Faerdref yn rhan o ardal Taf-elái yn Rhondda Cynon Taf. Mae wedi'i lleoli'n agos i'r A473 ac mae'n agos iawn at drefi Pontypridd a Llantrisant. Ar un adeg roedd yr hen A473 yn llwybr ag oedd â thagfeydd rheolaidd drwy Lanilltud Faerdref, Ton-teg a Phentre'r Eglwys, fodd bynnag, yn 2010 cafodd ffordd osgoi Pentre'r Eglwys (A473 newydd) ei chodi i liniaru'r tagfeydd traffig yma a chafodd y prif lwybr drwy'r cymunedau yma ei ail enwi, sef y B4595.

O fewn ardal Llanilltud Faerdref, mae tair ysgol gynradd (Maes y Bryn, Llanilltud Faerdref ac Ysgol Gymraeg Garth Olwg) yn ogystal ag un Ysgol Uwchradd (Ysgol Gyfun Gymraeg Garth Olwg). Mae cryn nifer o ddisgyblion sy'n mynychu'r ysgolion yma yn byw'n lleol ac yn defnyddio'r B4595 i gerdded i'r ysgol neu ddal eu bws ysgol.

Mae'r cyngor wedi ymchwilio i'r darpariaethau ar hyd y llwybr yma cyn gwneud cais a derbyn cyllid i wella'r llwybrau cerdded ar hyd y B4595.

Rhan o'r cyllid yma yw gwella'r Groesfan Pelican i fod yn Groesfan Pâl ar Ffordd Llantrisant, Llanilltud Faerdref i wella defnyddioldeb a diogelwch y groesfan drwy ddefnyddio synwryddion i bennu a yw'r groesfan yn glir.

Mae'r newidiadau yma yn cael eu hystyried yn angenrheidiol i gynnal a gwella diogelwch priffyrdd a cherddwyr ac, o bosibl, gwella llif traffig ar hyd y B4595.

(ALTERATION OF PEDESTRIAN CROSSING) NOTICE 2022

STATEMENT OF REASONS

The community of Llantwit Fardre is located in the Taff area of Rhondda Cynon Taff. It is situated adjacent to the A473 and is within close proximity to the towns of Pontypridd and Llantrisant. The former A473 was once a heavily congested strategic route through Llantwit Fardre, Tonteg and Church Village, however in 2010 the Church Village Bypass (new A473) was constructed to alleviate this traffic congestion and the main route through these communities was re-classified as the B4595.

Within the locality of Llantwit Fardre there are three primary schools (Maes Y Bryn, Llantwit Fardre and YG Garth Olwg) as well as one Secondary School (YGG Garth Olwg). A high number of pupils attending these schools live locally and utilise the B4595 to walk to school or catch their school bus.

The council has investigated the provisions provided along this route before subsequently bidding for and received funding to improve the walking routes along the B4595.

Part of this funding is to upgrade the existing Pelican type pedestrian crossing to a Puffin type pedestrian crossing on Llantrisant Road, Llantwit Fardre to improve the usability and the safety of the crossing through the use of sensors to determine if the crossing is clear

These changes are considered necessary to maintain and improve highway and pedestrian safety and potentially improve traffic flows along the B4595
