Dear Owner/ Occupier,

RE: Tyla Gwyn, Nantgarw – Changes to the Double Yellow Lines

I am writing to inform you of a proposed amendment to the highway markings on Tyla Gwyn, Nantgarw.

As part of this scheme, Rhondda Cynon Taf County Borough Council is proposing to extend the existing Double Yellow Line restrictions. The purpose of this extension is to improve visibility for all highway users along this stretch of road and to support the safe and efficient movement of vehicles, particularly larger vehicles, such as coaches visiting Nantgarw China Works.

By extending the Double Yellow Lines, the Council aims to reduce the risk of obstruction, maintain a clear line of sight for drivers, and ensure that sufficient space is available for the free flow of traffic. This measure is therefore considered necessary to safeguard access and improve overall road safety on Tyla Gwyn.

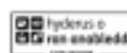
