IF256 - Proposed Waiting Restrictions – Llanharry Road, Danybryn, Brynsadler – Residents Consultation

Following longstanding concerns regarding parking issues in the vicinity of Danybryn, Brynsadler, the Council has investigated and developed proposals to introduce double yellow lines and a bus stop road marking in the area. These changes aim to improve highway safety and traffic flow.

The proposals include:

- **The introduction of double yellow lines** on sections of Danybryn, Llanharry Road and Bryn Terrace to prevent parking issues and improve visibility for all road users.
- **The implementation of a bus stop road marking** to ensure safe and accessible public transport facilities.

The Council is writing to all affected residents to advise of these proposals and provide the opportunity to submit observations and/or comments. Details of the proposals are shown on the attached drawing **TM25/261/FD**
