August 2025

Welcome to your second construction update from the team at Willmott Dixon Construction!

The project has progressed well since our first update – where we have had the delivery and install of our larger welfare units, which will be in place until the later stages of the project. Additionally, our site car park is complete allowing site vehicles to park within our boundary reducing the cars parked on the street. Works on the building footprint have advanced, we have commenced installation of steel reinforcement to the foundations, Internal and external drainage is ongoing, and the gas membrane has been placed.

#### **Overnight Working**

During the coming weeks, we will be pouring concrete for the foundations and the concrete slab. Unfortunately, the concrete slab pours will require the site to operate overnight on two separate occasions. This is unavoidable due to the time the power float process takes to achieve the correct concrete finish. We apologise in advance for any inconvenience caused and will endeavour to keep any disruption to a minimum. The first concrete pour is scheduled for Wednesday 20th August (or as soon as possible thereafter if we are unable to proceed on that date due to weather conditions).
