Dear Neighbour,

From the last newsletter update, we have progressed externally and internally on site in a variety of areas! Firstly, brickwork on the South elevation is complete and scaffolding has been dismantled. This has allowed the metal framing for cladding panels around the windows to begin. We are closely approaching finishing the North and West elevations of brickwork. The solar panels on the roof have also been installed.

Internally, the building is taking shape with the drylining (plasterboard) commencing, alongside our mechanical and electrical contractors. Throughout this month, the above work will continue to progress alongside the return of our groundwork contractors to start the external works, such as the Multi Use Games Area (MUGA) on the south elevation.
