

The results were used to influence the work of the RCT Together Team. "TOGETHER we DID" Increased the value of Community Grants from around £66k in 2020-2021 more £1.9m (approx.) in 2023-2024, benefiting 708 not for personal profit groups and organisation, who in turn provided support and activities that engaged with 42,129 individual RCT residents.
