# Community Asset Transfers (CAT) – Paddling Pools and Splashpad

Community Paddling pools and Splashpad provided free access to facilities along with events and other free activities such as free fruit, food, entertainment and games during the Summer Holiday period of 2025

- Treorchy Paddling Pool
- Lee Gardens Pool (Penrhiwceiber)
- Gwernifor Paddling Pool (Mt Ash)
- Butchers Pool (Ynysybwl?)

## Summer 2025 Highlights

### **Community Engagement and Visits**

Over 10,126 visits were recorded across five community-run pools and splashpads, highlighting their popularity.

### **Volunteer and Lifeguard Support**

The initiative employed **22 lifeguards** and engaged **62 volunteers** to ensure safe and smooth operation.

### **Fundraising and Social Impact**

Fundraising across the groups raised in excess of £89,238, enabling free access and activities, generating a social return of investment (SROI) for every £1 invested, it generated £37.07 of Social Value.

### **Pool Locations and Community Well-being**

The four pools and Splashpad enhanced community well-being with safe summer recreation spots.

## Safety and Maintenance

- Leisure ensured pool safety through lifeguard recruitment & training, water testing, and regular maintenance tasks. Approving repairs and negotiating agreements for water use to maintain facility operations.

## Facilities Management

- Corporate Estates managed lease renewals and updating Safe Operating Procedures in line with guidance from Leisure.

## Community Collaboration

- Community Development Team coordinated planning meetings and supported groups to access funding for activities.

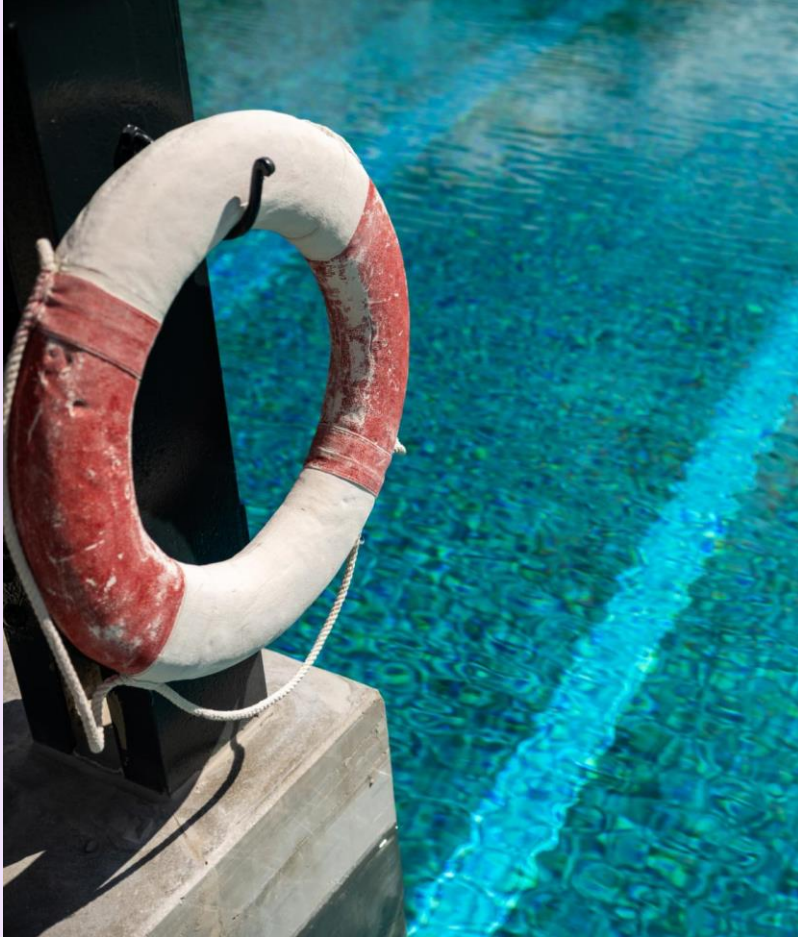

# Lifeguard Training



## Comprehensive Lifeguard Training

- A variety of training programs equipped lifeguards with essential qualifications and skills for pool safety and supervision. **17 people completed pool related training in 2025.**

## Succession Planning Strategy

- Lee Gardens Pool funded National Pool Lifeguard Qualification (NPLQ) for volunteers who repaid the cost through work shifts, ensuring future lifeguard availability.

## Career Development Opportunities

- The program supported career growth with some lifeguards moving into leisure centre roles, fostering community engagement. **22 x lifeguards were employed to support paddling pool activities in 2025.**

### Renovations and Improvements

- Significant upgrades improved water circulation and structural integrity of the paddling pool in 2025.

### Visitor Engagement

- The pool welcomed 838 visitors including children and adults, with many fun activities throughout summer including “ALN quiet sessions” which were appreciated by families.

### Volunteer Lifeguards

- Five new young volunteers trained and passed lifeguard exams, helping to ensure pool safety.

### Community Support

- A GoFundMe campaign raised over £5,095 in 24 hours to fix a pump, showing strong local support. Thank you also to Pen Y Cymoedd and RCT Council for additional funding.

### Summer Season Success

- Lee Gardens Pool attracted nearly 5,000 visits in 31 days during the successful 2025 summer season, with 794 individual children and 540 individual adults attending.

### Lifeguard Training and Staffing

- Six lifeguards trained to NPLQ standards replaced volunteers, supported by dedicated staff and payroll services. We continue to pay for the training of volunteer lifeguards & watching them flourish is very rewarding. Huge thanks go to Megan, Morgan, Ella, Cody, Lowri and Carter who gave up their summer holiday to do lifeguarding at the pool.

### Accessibility and Inclusion

- Pool accessibility improved with ramps and aqua wheelchairs, fostering an inclusive, welcoming environment for all visitors.

### Community Support and Funding

- Funding from local organizations including RCT Council, Interlink & Welsh Church Act covered operational costs, enabling maintenance and various community programs.



24 volunteers and 7 staff kept everyone fed, watered and safe. Thanks also to St Winifreds Church (Penrhiwceiber) for organising the food for Street Games and Fit & Fed

- Celebrating a decade of community engagement, the splashpad is praised for fun, safety, and weather suitability.

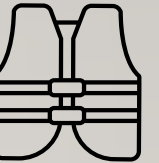

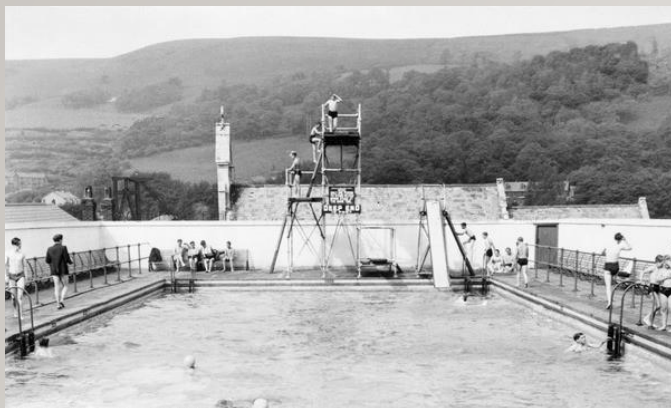

## Inclusive Quiet Sessions

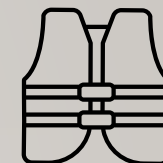
- Weekly quiet sessions were held every Thursday to support children with Additional Learning Needs.
