RADAR

What is a Radar Key?

A RADAR Key (sometimes called an NKS Key) is a large, silver-coloured skeleton key that opens more than 10,000 locked, disabled toilets in the UK.

The RADAR key is part of the National Key Scheme (NKS), giving thousands of people with disabilities and health conditions independent access to locked public toilets around the country. The Radar Key Scheme enables these disabled toilets to be locked to prevent vandalism and misuse, while also being readily available to those who really need them.

For a small charge a RADAR key can be purchased giving you access to disabled toilets across the UK. There are a number of places which stock the RADAR key including the Blue Badge Company, www.radarkey.org and www.bladderand bowel.org

Chatterbox is run by RCT Carers Project staff who are available to answer any queries, offer signposting or are simply there for a cuppa and a chat.



WaterSure Wales can help with your charges if you have a water meter and receive at least one of the qualifying benefits/tax credits:

Income Support

Income Related Employment &

Support Allowance

Income-based Jobseeker's Allowance

Pension Credit

Housing Benefit

Attendance Allowance (AA)

Working Tax Credit

Child Tax Credit (except families in receipt of the

family element only)

Universal Credit

Disability Living Allowance (DLA)

Personal Independence Payment (PIP)

AND

You have 3 or more children under the age of 19, living at your home who you claim Child Benefit for.

OR

You or a member of your household has a medical condition that requires SIGNIFICANT use of extra water.

Desquamation (flaky skin disease)

Weeping Skin (eczema, psoriasis, varicose

ulceration)

Incontinence

Abdominal Stoma

Crohn's Disease

Renal failure requiring home dialysis (except where the health authority contributes to the cost of the

The WaterSure Wales charges are £130.89 for water and £189.06 for sewerage for the period 1 April 2018 to 31 March 2019.

Please note:

You don't qualify for WaterSure Wales if:

You don't have a water meter fitted at your property. If you'd like to have a meter fitted to qualify, please complete the WaterSure Wales application form, including the meter application form on page 5.

You water your garden with a non-handheld appliance, such as a sprinkler or domestic irrigation system.

You have a swimming pool or pond with a capacity of over 10,000 litres.

This isn't your main home.

Your property is used for commercial purposes.

You share payment of your bill with your neighbour(s).

Upper Rhondda Support Group



Upper Rhondda support group was started in September 2017.

The group was started by the Rhondda memory team in collaboration with Saint Matthews's church.

The group is for anyone affected by dementia whether that be a person with a diagnosis, family, carers or friends.

At the time the memory team felt there was nothing being offered in a community setting for people with Dementia so set about changing that with the support of St Matthews's church. Originally the group started with just one date a month but having proven so popular a second date was added so since April the group has been running twice a month.

The group offers peer support in a friendly welcoming environment and hopes to combat social isolation and provide stimulating activities to all. A small group of volunteers provided by the church all received dementia awareness training via the Rhondda memory team and now support the group at every session.

The Rhondda memory team are also present at every session to provide professional advice and support if needed.

Off the back of the success of the group we have also recently been able to run a trip to Porthcawl,

and have received support from drink wise age well who have provided activity sessions such as indoor curling to our group.

At our Christmas session we were lucky enough to have two local primary school choirs perform for our group and we hope to maintain that link and do some intergenerational work in the future.

The group runs mainly off donations and recently received an amount of funding from the carers project.


