Childcare team update

Priorities for Autumn term include focusing on the North Taf Ely area to further explore the childcare needs of parents and continuing to recruit new childminders.

The CSA action plan has also been updated for year one and is available to view at **www.rctcbc.gov.uk/csa**.

We are keen to support unregistered settings and nannies. This can be with 1:1 support to register with CIW, business advice, access to training or signposting to other agencies. Please get in touch if you would like our support or let us know of any other settings/ nannies that would like to join our mailing list.

As always, we are committed to recruiting and supporting new childminders. We have a tailored package of support and work with partners to promote childminding as a career. If you know of anyone who is interested in becoming a childminder, please pass our details onto them.

National Minimum Standards

As you know, there are some changes to the NMS. These changes include:

- Updated requirements for First Aid and Safeguarding training
- Childminding Assistants now need to complete their IHC module

We are currently sourcing updated Safeguarding training to ensure it complies and hope to offer these spaces to you soon. We have increased our First Aid training provision and these dates have been sent out. Please contact us if you have not received these dates.

For Childminding Assistants, we have a funding package available for those operating within RCT. If you have any Assistants that need to complete this course, please contact the team. Please remember that all Assistants need to complete this training by the end of November 2023, so get in touch with us!

Training

Our training programme for Autumn term has been advertised via Facebook and email. Places are filling fast but some are still available. If you have lost the schedule, get in touch and we will resend to you.

Remember to let us know if you can't attend as soon as possible so we can offer that place to someone else. Non-attendance is still a big problem, wasting money and meaning we can't demonstrate that this funded training is needed by the Sector. Last year we saw a 42% non-attendance rate across all training offered by the Childcare Team. Help us to help you and let us know if you can't attend.

Childcare Offer for Wales

The new national system has now been running for a few months. Welsh Government continue to refine it and make updates. If you have any feedback, please let us know and we can pass it on.

Children who remained on the old, legacy system are no longer eligible and that system has now been shut down. All claims on the old system should have been submitted by the end of August. If you have any queries about the old system, please get in touch.

A couple of reminders for the national system:

- Funding is paid in arrears. However, you can claim weekly
- Once we've approved parent applications, they must set up an agreement on the system with you for the agreed term time and holiday hours. They must do this by the Sunday each week to be able to claim funding from the week after
- You must approve agreements by the Thursday each week for that agreement to show on your claim on the Friday
- Children can still access the Offer in holiday periods, even if they are full time in school (until the September following their 4th birthday)


School Admissions

- **Pre-nursery for January 2024 start** Applications opened 1 September 2023, close 29 September 2023, decision letters sent by 10 November 2023
- Nursery for September 2024 start Applications opened 1 September 2023, close 11 November 2023, decision letters sent by 16 April 2024
