Over the last decade, we've delivered £1.16 billion of investment across Rhondda Cynon Taf, transforming our communities. At the same time, we have set the lowest cumulative council tax rise of any Welsh local authority.

We've transformed education with £410 million invested in 23 major school projects and ongoing upgrades. Our roads, bridges and flood defences have benefited from £237 million, strengthening key routes and supporting long-term recovery from Storm Dennis.

More than £230 million has driven regeneration and transport improvements, including the Cross Valley Link, A4119 dualling, and Llys Cadwyn as part of the wider transformation of Pontypridd.

We've invested £87 million in housing, helping people live independently and bringing empty homes back into use, while our parks, leisure centres and play areas have seen £57 million of improvements, including 17 new 3G pitches.

And we've also invested £25 million in social care as part of a wider £90m programme, delivering new facilities for older residents.
