The Welsh Government ReAct+ programme includes an Employer Recruitment and Training subsidy.

By taking on an eligible recruit, an employer can receive up to £3000* to help towards wages for the first 12 months. *An additional £1000 is available to employers who recruit a disabled person or a young person who is not in education, employment or training. Employers who recruit a young disabled person who is not in education, employment or training can receive an additional £2000. This employer

recruitment support will be paid in quarterly instalments. To help sharpen the skills of an eligible new recruit, an employer can receive up to £1000 for job-related skills training.

The Employer Recruitment Subsidy is administered by Business Wales ReAct+ | Business Wales Skills Gateway (gov.wales)
