DYMA HYSBYSIAD bod Cyngor Bwrdeistref Sirol Rhondda Cynon Taf yn bwriadu gwneud Gorchymyn, ar ôl o leiaf 7 diwrnod o ddyddiad yr Hysbysiad hwn, o dan Adran 14 o Ddeddf Rheoleiddio Traffig Ffyrdd 1984, fel y'i diwygiwyd gan Ddeddf Traffig Ffyrdd (Cyfyngiadau Dros Dro) 1991, a fydd yn para ddeunaw mis ar y mwyaf. Effaith y Gorchymyn fydd: -

- Gwahardd dros dro unrhyw berson rhag achosi i unrhyw gerbyd aros ar unrhyw adeg ar hyd y rhannau canlynol o'r ffyrdd: -**

Rhiw'r Mynach, Aberdâr

- Ochr ogledd-orllewinol, o'i chyffordd â Highland Place i'w chyffordd â Tŷ Fry / Unity Street
- Ochr ogledd-orllewinol, o'i chyffordd â Tŷ Fry / Unity Street, tua'r gogledd-ddwyrain am bellter o 96 metr
- Ochr dde-ddwyrainol, o'i chyffordd â Trevor Street tua'r de-orllewin am bellter o 115 metr

- Gwahardd dros dro unrhyw berson rhag achosi i unrhyw gerbyd deithio ar hyd y rhannau canlynol o'r ffyrdd**

- Unity Street / Ty Fry, o'i chyffordd â Rhiw'r Mynach i'w chyffordd â Graig Street
- Ynysllwyd Street, o'i chyffordd â Rhiw'r Mynach tua'r gogledd-ddwyrain am bellter o 20 metr
- Trevor Street, o'i chyffordd â Rhiw'r Mynach tua'r de-ddwyrain am bellter o 35 metr

Mae llwybrau eraill i gerbydau fel a ganlyn:

- ochr ddwyreiniol y rhan sy wedi'i chau, ewch ar hyd Rhiw'r Mynach, Highland Place, Tŷ Fry, Graig Street a Pendarren i ochr orllewinol y rhan sydd wedi'i chau.
- ochr ddeheuol y rhan sydd wedi'i chau, ewch ar hyd Rhiw'r Mynach, Mary Street ac Ynysllwyd Street i ochr ogleddol y rhan sydd wedi'i chau.
- ochr orllewinol y ffordd sydd wedi'i chau, ewch ar hyd Trevor Street, Tanybryn Street, Mary Street a Rhiw'r Mynach i ochr ddwyreiniol y rhan sydd wedi'i chau.

Yn achos gyrwyr sy'n teithio i'r cyfeiriad arall, bydd eisiau dilyn y cyfarwyddiadau uchod yn y drefn wrthol.

Mae disgwyl i'r Gorchymyn fod mewn grym o 3 Ebrill 2018 tan 15 Ebrill 2018, neu hyd nes i'r gwaith gael ei orffen.

Mae angen y cyfyngiad fel bydd modd cynnal y gwaith ar y ffordd neu yn ei hymyl.

Fydd DIM mynediad i gerbydau gwasanaethau brys.

Bydd mynediad ar gael i gerddwyr.

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Rhondda Cynon Taff County Borough Council intends, not less than 7 days from the date of this Notice, to make an Order under Section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, which will have a maximum duration of eighteen months. The effect of the Order will be to: -

- Temporarily prohibit any person from causing any vehicle to wait at anytime on the following lengths of roads: -**

Monk Street, Aberdare

- North western side, from its junction with Highland Place to its junction with Ty Fry/Unity Street
- North western side, from its junction with Ty Fry/Unity Street, north eastwards for a distance of 96m
- South eastern side, from its junction with Trevor Street, south westwards for a distance of 115m

- Temporarily prohibit any person from causing any vehicle to proceed along the following lengths of roads**

- Unity Street/Ty Fry, from its junction with Monk Street to its junction with Graig Street
- Ynysllwyd Street, from its junction with Monk Street, north eastwards for a distance of 20m
- Trevor Street, from its junction with Monk Street, south eastwards for a distance of 35m

The alternative routes for vehicles are as follows:

- From the eastern side of the closure, proceed via Monk Street, Highland Place, Ty Fry, Graig Street and Pendarren to the western side of the closure.
- From the southern side of the closure, proceed via Monk Street, Mary Street and Ynysllwyd Street to the northern side of the closure
- From the western side of the closure, proceed via Trevor Street, Tanybryn Street, Mary Street and Monk Street to the eastern side of the closure

For vehicles travelling in the opposite direction, reverse the directions given above.

It is expected to be operative from 3rd April 2018 to 15th April 2018 or until such time as the works are completed

The restriction is necessary to enable works to be carried out on or near the road.

Access will be NOT be maintained for emergency vehicles.

Access will be maintained for pedestrians.
