- b. Yr ochr ogledd-ddwyreiniol, o bwynt sy'n unol â llinell ymyl gogledd-orllewinol Maes Bryn Hyfryd, tua'r gogledd-orllewin am bellter o 10.4 metr

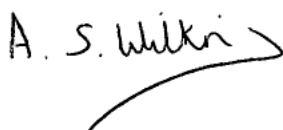
2. Maes Bryn Hyfryd

- a. Y ddwy ochr, o'i chyffordd â Heol y Berth i gyfeiriad y gogledd-ddwyrain am bellter o 7.5 metr

3. Stryd Thomas

- a. Yr ochr ogledd-orllewinol o'i chyffordd â Heol y Berth, tua'r de-orllewin am bellter o 3.9 metr
- b. Yr ochr dde-ddwyreiniol, o'i chyffordd â Heol y Berth, tua'r de-orllewin am bellter o 6.8 metr

(WAITING RESTRICTIONS) ORDER 2026

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Rhondda Cynon Taff County Borough Council propose to make an Order under Sections 1, 2 and 4 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act"), and of all other enabling powers, the effect of which will be to:

1. Introduce Waiting Restrictions on the lengths of roads specified in the Schedule

SCHEDULE – Prohibition of Waiting At Any Time

1. Bush Road

- a. The south-western side, from a point 1.5 metres south of a point in line with the north-western property boundary of No. 28 Glancynon Street, north-westwards for a distance of 54 metres
- b. The north-eastern side, from a point in line with the north-western kerbline of Mount Pleasant Place, north-westwards for a distance of 10.4 metres

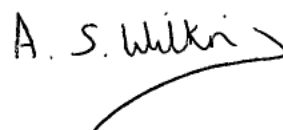
2. Mount Pleasant Place

- a. Both sides, from its junction with Bush Road, north-eastwards for a distance of 7.5 metres.

3. Thomas Street

- a. The north-western side, from its junction with Bush Road, south-westwards for a distance of 3.9 metres
- b. The south-eastern side, from its junction with Bush Road, south-westwards for a distance of 6.8 metres
