## Dangerous Tree Questionnaire

In order for an Officer to consider whether a tree is in such a condition that it is likely to cause damage to persons or property the following information needs to be gathered. **If you cannot provide all the required information, the Public Health and Protection Department will not be able to action your complaint and you will be requested to provide additional evidence.**

1. Name, address & contact details of the complainant	
2. Address and map detailing the location of the tree	
3. Land ownership details (please attach a copy of the Land Registry record) <a href="https://www.gov.uk/search-property-information-land-registry">https://www.gov.uk/search-property-information-land-registry</a>	
4. Details of action taken to resolve the matter with the land owner. Including copies of letters/correspondence requesting action.	
5. Type of tree	
6. Approximate height of tree	
7. A copy of the professional arborist report or signed letter from arborist confirming tree is in a dangerous condition.	

8. Details of attached photographs.	
9. Is the condition of the tree likely to be a danger to persons? If yes, please outline how?	
10. Is the tree likely to cause structural damage to property? If yes, what will be affected?

I understand that if any of these items are not included Public Health will be unable to take any further action.
