Tramroad Walk	Take a guided walk along the 1809 Tramroad Trail that starts right in our car park! This guided walk leads children along the route of Dr Richard Griffiths' Tramroad which was built to link the first coal mines in the Rhondda Valley with the Glamorganshire Canal. Virtual Reality 3D headsets

These are only available to Rhondda Cynon Taf schools upon booking the guided underground tour. The headsets can be taken back to school where pupils will be able to virtually explore our outdoor courtyard. The headsets also include Cwm Rhondda - the first educational virtual reality mining experience in the UK. Explore over 200 metres of tunnels, an interactive coal face, stables and watch five short educational films.

On site interactive exhibition

On site, visitors can explore the interactive exhibition with footage from the archives, quizzes and puzzles focusing on the history of the coal industry in the Rhondda.
